Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

### Administrative:

Trainer D. Scott Peck has appealed Stewards ruling 41-2014, to the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission. The appeal is concerning his "Methocarbamol" positive, fine of \$1,000 and the disqualification of the horse "Hiram" from the second race on Thursday, June 5, 2014.

We received a report from Dr. Mary A. Robinson, director of the Pennsylvania Equine Toxicology & Research Laboratory. The report was concerning the referee sample #0040459 taken from the horse "A. P. Wild" the winner of the second race on May 21, 2014, for trainer Juan Vazquez. The referee sample for "Stanozolol" was negative. No action shall be taken in this matter.

#1a, “Terry Blossom,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Loomin’ Lori Lou,” and #6, “Nicki Flash,” were scratched as main-track only. #1, “Bogelia,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:51 p.m.**  
Horacio Karamanos, the scheduled rider on the #11, “Olga Payne,” was changed to Forest Boyce; no double jocks mount. #3, “Hotspur Harriett,” was scratched by the trainer. #4, “Bringhamthecrown,” was scratched as main-track only. #12, “Honey Springs,” #13, “Subtle Demeanor,” and #14, “Swift Nettles,” were scratched as alternates. #8, “Calm Reply,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START AND IN THE STRETCH** - Hold and claim of foul by Daniel Centeno the rider of #8 “Calm Reply,” against Jose Beatencourt, the rider of the #9, “Cimbria,” for coming in bumping him shortly after the start. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #9 came in bumping the #8 shortly after the start. The #9 was disqualified from 2<sup>nd</sup> and placed 4<sup>th</sup> behind the #8 who was moved up to 3<sup>rd</sup> from 4<sup>th</sup>. Hold and claim of foul by Jose Betancourt the rider of #9 “Cimbra,” against Victor Carrasco, the rider of the #1, “Southern Peach,” for coming out and bumping him, in the stretch. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the inside horses came out forcing the #1 out into the #9. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action in the stretch run, making the race official.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 8 - 9.” Starters - 9**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:27 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:28 p.m.** J. D. Acosta, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Hurler,” was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. #2, “Whyprolongtheagony,” and #3, “Silent Tap,” were vet scratches. #7, “Hurler,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. #7, “Hurler,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #7, “Hurler,” requested a \$140.00 all inclusive special test. #7, “Hurler,” reared up at the start, breaking slowly.

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:57 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:58 p.m.** #1, “Hesster,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #6, “Dr Burn” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.
