Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science revealed the following:

- Samples collected from Thursday, July 31, 2014 were all clear with the exception of #44707 and #44712 which are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Samples collected from Saturday, August 2, 2014 were all clear.
- Samples collected from Monday, August 4, 2014 were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Skylar,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Do Ya Wanna,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH – #5, “Redneck Lazy,”** with rider Alex Cintron was lugging in during the stretch run, causing jockey, Horacio Karamanos aboard the #2, “Sir Celtic Express,” to take up and go to the outside. Since the #2 had beaten the #5, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #6, “Warrensburg,” was claimed by King Star - Juan Vazquez. The owner-trainer that claimed the #6, “Warrensburg,” requested a \$140.00 all inclusive special test.

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m.
The distance for this race has been changed from 71/2 on the turf, to 1 mile on the main track. Kendrick Carmouche, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Bai Bai Baby,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. #2, “Savannah Mist,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Just Like Kaki,” and #9, “Miss Bullistic,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #3, “She Raised the Bar,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #7, “Fish and Chips,” was eased and pulled up by its rider Luis Garcia at the ½ mile pole due to his saddle slipping forward.
