Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science revealed the following:

- Samples #44814 and #44819 from July 10, 2014, which were both on hold while awaiting a certificate of analysis, were cleared.
- Sample #44683 which was collected on July 26, 2014 was also cleared.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “My Tip,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH** – Hold and claim of foul by Erasmo Martinez the rider of the #6, “Jeb’s Brew,” against the #1, “My Tip,” with rider Javier Santiago, stating that the #1 came out in the stretch, taking his path away. The #1 was well in front of the #6 when he came out in the stretch run. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action, and made the race official.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 6 - 4.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:49 p.m. #6, “Livonzin,” was scratched as a main-track only.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 8

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m. Hold and Claim of foul by jockey Fray Martinez aboard the #6, “Quiet Dinero,” against the #7, “Eruzlie Dantor,” ridden by Carlos Luis Gutierrez. During interview, Martinez stated that the #7 came in down the stretch taking his path away. Examination of the video by the Stewards determined that the #7 comes in a little at the top of the stretch but left plenty of room for the #6 on the rail. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. No Inquiry was called in this race.

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:25 p.m. Jevian Toledo, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Dance the Rumba,” was changed to Luis Garcia; no double jocks mount. #7, “Penumbra,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Dance the Rumba,” was eased past the finish line.

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:55 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:58 p.m.
Jomar Ortega, the scheduled rider on the #7, “How Cool Is He,” was changed to Jose Vega; no double jocks mount. Joshua Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #8, “No Offence,” was changed to Javier Santiago; no double jocks mount. #2, “Gallivanting,” was a vet scratch. #10, “Rocket Reign,” was scratched as an alternate. #7, “How Cool is He,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 9 - 8.” Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:29 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:30 p.m. #3, “Donita’s Ruler,” was a vet scratch. Javier Santiago, the rider on the #1, “Mary’s Mystique,” was unseated after pulling up while returning to the unsaddling area. Jockey Santiago was transported to the hospital for observation.

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:00 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:01 p.m. Jordano Tunon, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Avie’s Pegasus,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. #7, “Costa de Oro,” was selected for a blood gas test. #5, “Secret Jackpot,” was claimed by Walnut Hill Stable LLC – Randy Nunley.
