Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science revealed the following:

- Samples collected from Thursday, August 7, 2014 were all clear with the exception of #44972, #44974, #44975 and #44976 which are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Samples collected from Saturday, August 9, 2014 were all clear.
- Samples collected from Monday, August 11, 2014 were all clear, with the exception of #50500 which is on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

A claim in for the #1, “The Silver Machine,” by King Star – Juan Vazquez was **VOID** as the claim amount was not entered on the claim blank. #2, “Social Statement,” was claimed by Kenneth L. and Sarah K. Ramsey – Darci Rice.

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:52 p.m. Pedro Requena, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Northeast Princess,” was changed to Kerwin Clark; no double jocks mount. #10, “Primero de Mayo,” #11, “Irish Heiress,” #12 Another Taste,” #13, “Double Dinnermint” and #14, “Momma’s Mystery” were scratched as alternates. The #6, “Northeast Princess,” was eased past the finish line. The rider of the #6 Kerwin Clark was interviewed and informed the Stewards that the horse was not travelling well, so he eased her past the finish line. #8, “Sandy the Bear,” was selected for a blood gas test.
