**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science revealed the following:

- Samples collected from Wednesday, August 13, 2014 were all clear with the exception of #50509 and #50515 which are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m.** #7, “Two Punch Too,” was a vet scratch. After the race the #3, “Throw the Dice,” suffered from heat prostration, and was treated by Chief Commission Veterinarian John Peters.

Sanchez, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Angelic Faith,” was changed to Yamil Rosario; no double jocks mount. #5, “Thunder Ranger,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Calzini Rossi,” was a trainer scratch. #10, “Si Cology,” and #12, “Rule Five,” were scratched as alternates. #7, “Pasta Giovanni,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 8 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 9**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:22 p.m.** Jose Ferreira, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Little Pisano,” was changed to Yamil Rosario; no double jocks mount. #2, “Catangelic,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #3, “Slewdious,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:55 p.m.** #10, “Dearest One,” #11, “Worldly Charm,” #12, “Pedal Princess,” and #13, “I Tellthejokeshere,” were scratched as alternates. #5, “Stormy Situation,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 9**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:25 p.m.**

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 6**

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:55 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:58 p.m.** #6, “Private Tutor,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Cerro (IRE),” #2, “Hard Aces,” #3, “Flashy Sunrise,” #12, “A. P. Cino,” and #13, “Concealed Identity,” were scratched as main-track only. #7, “Koh I Noor,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 9 - 10 - 8.” Starters - 7**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:28 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:29 p.m.** #2, “Mountain Sprite,” and #3, “Jessica’s Reason,” were vet scratches. #6, “On Balance,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The #7, “Sandbag,” charged the gate just prior to the starting of the race. During nterview of jockey Jose Caraballo he stated that the horse charged the gate, and when the assistant pulled the horse back, the starter started the race. We could see no video evidence of the assistant starter having hold of the horse when the gates opened. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official.

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:59 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:00 p.m.** Cecily Evans, the scheduled rider on the #6, “Bell South,” was changed to Jomar Ortega; no double jocks mount. #1, “BR Dance In Red,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Special P,” was selected for a blood gas test.
