Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Tinder Lord,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 2 - 5.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. #1, “Bundestag (GB),” and #4, “Namron,” were vet scratches. #3, “Motor City,” and #6, “Dinny Dinosaur,” were scratched as main-track only.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 8 - 10 – 5.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m. #1, “Cee ‘n O,” #5, “Golden Rings,” and #6, “Silvertonguedtommy,” were vet scratches. #2, “Run to the Limit,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Place and Show wagering for this race as we were below four betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 – 2.” Starters - 3

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:52 p.m. #10, “Rock ‘n Roman,” #11, “Paddington,” #12, “Colmont Kid,” #13, “Determining,” and #14, “Biricchino,” were scratched as alternates. **INQUIRY AT THE TOP OF THE**

STRETCH - #7, “Ransom Paid,” with rider Michael Cleere, fell at the top of the stretch.

After reviewing the video, we could not detect the reason that the #7 horse fell.

Consequently, no action was taken and the race was made official. Jockey Cleere was transported to first aid and examined by EMT Mike Cooper. EMT Cooper reported that the rider refused medical treatment and signed a refusal of treatment form. Associate Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown examined the #7 horse and reported that the horse was uninjured.

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:25 p.m. #1, “Her Royalship,” and #4, “Mary’s Mystique,” were vet scratches. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. The #5, “Don’tstop Theparty,” with rider Jose Caraballo appeared to stumble at the start. We spoke with Jockey Caraballo who said the horse broke slowly and was off in the back end and not able to push off.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 3 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 5

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:55 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:57 p.m. #3, “Doctor S,” was a trainer scratch. #6, “Fudge E,” and #12, “Pomeroy’s Package,” were vet scratches. #1a, “Stourbridge Lion,” #4, Atomic Orange Vet,” #8, “Cusabo,” and #9, “Pushin On,” were scratched as main-track only. #13, “Golden Story,” was scratched as an alternate. #1, “Bert B Don,” was selected for a blood gas test. Following the race, the #1, “Bert B Don.” pulled up sore and was transported from the racing surface via horse ambulance. Chief Commission Veterinarian, John Peters reported that “Bert B Don” was off in the left front.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 7 - 10 - 11.” Starters - 7

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:27 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:29 p.m. #1, “Guam Typhoon,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Good Feng Shui,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 – 1a - 3 - 6.” Starters - 7

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:59 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:00 p.m. #1a, “Age of Aquarius,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Juliet’s Promise,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Juliet’s Promise,” was claimed by Gold Starr Racing LLC – Scott Lake. #5, “Hailey’s Star,” was claimed by Warwick Stable – A. Ferris Allen III.
