Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science revealed the following:

- Sample #50517 from July 14, 2014, is on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Samples #50527 and #50530 from July 16, 2014, are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Samples from July 18, 2014, are all clear.
- All out of competition samples for August, are clear.

**Administrative:**

On Tuesday, August 26, 2014 trainer Murray Rojas and Steward Jack Houghton Jr. packaged and shipped her split sample to the referee laboratory Industrial Labs in Wheat Ridge Colorado, to confirm the presence of “Dexamethasone” which was discovered in the post-race sample #44839 from the horse “Barracuda Wayne” who finished 1st in the 3rd race on July 12, 2014.

We conducted a hearing today for trainer A. Ferris Allen III, for entering and running the horse “Spell Buddha” while the horse was on the Veterinarians list at Penn National Race Course. The horse “Spell Buddha” will be disqualified from all purse monies in this race for being ineligible at the time of entry and racing.

Accredited Alternate Steward Sharon Gunther is substituting for Fritz Burkhardt, starting at 3:00 p. m. today.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:21 p.m.** #4, “Monsta Missile,” was a late scratch as he broke through the gate prior to the start, running off 7/8 of a mile before being caught by the outriders. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The #1, “Tremont Street,” refused to break at the start. It was noted that the gate opened properly with the assistant starter letting the horse go immediately. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 5**

**SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:53 p.m.** Joshua Navarro, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Stormy Mama,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. #10, “Amber Morning,” was scratched as an alternate.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 9**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:23 p.m.** #3, “Miss Andorra,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Close Mystery,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “Tahaddi,” stumbled at the start.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 6**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:55 p.m.** #4, “Let’s Punch Bill,” was a vet scratch. #3, “I Tellthejokeshere,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 3 - 1.” Starters – 6**

**FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:27 p.m.** #1, “Brooks Lass,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START** – Hold and claim of foul, by the #5 and #6 against the #8 shortly after the start. The #8, “Sydney Speaks,” with rider Alex Cintron came in shortly after the start, bumping and pushing in the #7, “Storming Rage,” ridden by Angel Suarez, which in turn caused the #7 to push in the #6, “Pennies Appeal,” with rider Victor Carrasco, who then pushed in the #5, “Mendassity,” with rider J. D. Acosta. The #8 was disqualified from 4<sup>th</sup> and placed 6<sup>th</sup> behind the #6 who was moved up to fourth and the #5 who was moved up to 5<sup>th</sup>.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 4 - 7 - 6.” Starters - 9**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:57 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:58 p.m.**

**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 7**

**SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:27 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:29 p.m.** Alex Cintron, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Daylight Ride,” was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #8, “Game Fair,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Speedy First (KOR),” #3, “Cassatt,” and #9, “Awesome Mama,” were scratched as main-track only. #7, “Brenda’s Way,” was scratched as a main-track only as the racing office had entered the horse incorrectly. #6, “Perfect Measure,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.
