



# Daily Log Stewards Report Delaware Park

Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

### Administrative:

We held two hearing's today for exercise rider, Rafael Chinchilla-Suarzo. The first hearing was for testing positive for Cocaine, a first offense, on August 14, 2014. Mr. Chinchilla-Suarzo was required to attend a drug and alcohol program. After being tested prior to reinstatement on August 28, 2014, Rafael Chinchilla-Suarzo tested positive for Cocaine, a second time. For a second positive drug offense Mr. Chinchilla-Suarzo was suspended for a period of six months, from Monday, September 1, 2014 through and including Sunday, March 1, 2015. Mr. Chinchilla-Suarzo shall also be required to complete a drug and alcohol counseling program.

Two jockeys were randomly selected for drug testing. One rider tested negative while the other one participated in suspicious behavior and will be called in for a meeting with the Stewards on September 2, 2014 and re-tested.

Three other licensees were tested today. All three tested negative.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m.** Fray Martinez the scheduled rider on the #1, "Pro Prospect," was changed to Erasmo Martinez; no double jocks mount. #1, "Pro Prospect," was selected for a blood gas test. #4, "Jazz Age," broke slowly.

**SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m.** Ricardo Chiappe the scheduled rider on the #4, "Track Telling," was changed to Erasmo Martinez; no double jocks mount. #6, "It's Time to Reign," was scratched by its trainer. #8, "No Offence," was selected for a blood gas test.

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:20 p.m.** #7, “Quick N Proud,” was selected for a blood gas test. #8, “Artic Bird,” was a vet scratch.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 7**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:53 p.m.** Daniel Centeno the scheduled rider on the #10, “Dance With Ron,” was changed to Carol Ceden; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Callipepla,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Where’s the Risk,” was a trainer scratch. #1, “Looking Great,” was distanced, being eased in the stretch. Its rider, Andrew Wolfsont advised the Stewards that the horse only had one eye and bolted to the outside, and that he could not get her to run after she bolted.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 5 - 6 - 8.” Starters - 9**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:24 p.m.** Jose Vega the scheduled rider on the #4, “Bringhamethecrown,” was changed to Yamil Rosario; no double jocks mount. #3, “Chispi Affair,” was a vet scratch. #1, “High Wire Act,” pulled up lame after the race and was attended by Chief Commission Veterinarian, John Peters. Following his examination, Dr. Peters reported that “High Wire Act,” was off in the right front. Subsequently, the horse was transported from the racing surface via horse ambulance.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 2 - 7.” Starters - 6**

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:54 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:57 p.m.** #1a, “Its Closing Time,” #4, “Awesome Mama,” and #9, “Speedy First (KOR),” were scratched as main-track only.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 7**

**SEVENTH RACE – THE CREE RUN OAKS ARABIAN STAKES Grade II – POST TIME – 4:27 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:28 p.m.** #6, “Ivory Shores,” was scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #3, “Top Thess,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 6**

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS – THE BOB MAGNESS MEMORIAL ARABIAN STAKES Grade II - POST TIME – 4:58 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:01 p.m.** #5, “Quick and Rich,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START –** The #3, “RB Code,” ducked in shortly after the start, unseating jockey Yamil Rosario. The Stewards could see no reason to take any action and made the race official. Jockey Rosario returned to his feet and walked off of the racing surface.
