Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science revealed the following:

- Samples #50577, #50581 and #50582 from August 27, 2014, are on hold pending a certificate of analysis.
- LGC Science reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #44553, taken from the horse “R B Justify” which ran in the 8<sup>th</sup> race on Monday, June 9, 2014, contained “Phenylbutazone,” in the amount of 2.99 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. The trainer of record, Randy Nunley, was informed of this laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector Swift conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Nunley’s assigned barn area. Inspection revealed phenylbutazone tablets. Mr. Nunley waived his right to a hearing and accepted the penalty of a \$500.00 dollar fine for a first offense phenylbutazone overage.
- LGC Science reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #44808, taken from the horse “Quieenie’s Song” which ran in the 6<sup>th</sup> race on Wednesday, July 9, 2014, contained a combination of “Flunixin” and “Phenylbutazone.” The trainer of record, Graham Motion, was informed of this laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector Swift conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Motion’s assigned barn area. Results of the inspection revealed no medications.

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m.** #1, “Rock Slide Johnny,” was claimed by Worcester Investments LLC – Henry Worcester IV. #5, “Possession Arrow,” broke slowly.

We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:22 p.m.** Carol Cedeno the scheduled rider on the #1, “Silent Tap,” was changed to Kaylia Albright; no double jocks mount. #3, “Quarterback Sneak,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Camp Floyd,” was claimed by King Star – Juan Vazquez. The owner – trainer that claimed the #4, “Camp Floyd,” requested a \$140.00 all inclusive special test. A claim in for the #4 “Camp Floyd,” by Auto Baun Stable Inc. - Ruben Monjes was **VOID** as the trainer’s name was spelled incorrectly. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

After a two-way shake, #5, “Tuxedo Ray,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #5, “Tuxedo Ray,” requested a \$140.00 all inclusive special test.

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:22 p.m.** Erasmo Martinez the scheduled rider on the #1a, “Dual Exhauzt,” was changed to Kerwin Clark; no double jocks mount. #1, “Guam Typhoon,” was scratched as party of a same-owner entry. #2, “Dighton,” and #3, “Barracuda Wayne,” were vet scratches. #6, “Silvertonguedtommy,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “How Convenient,” was claimed by Joseph E. Besecker – Jamie Ness. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.
