Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science revealed the following:

- Samples from August 28, 2014, are all clear.
- Samples #50596, and #50600 from August 30, 2014, are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Samples #50604, #50608, #50610 and #50611 from September 1, 2014, are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- LGC Science reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #44976, taken from the horse “Dinny Dinosaur” which ran in the 8th race on Thursday, August 7, 2014, contained “Triamcinolone Acetonide,” in the amount of 125 picograms per milliliter of plasma. The trainer of record, Randy Nunley, was informed of this laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector’s Swift and Delaney conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Nunley’s assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed phenylbutazone tablets, wind aid, a bottle labeled “head-wash” and clenbuterol. Mr. Nunley was informed of his right to a split sample and advised he would let the Stewards know of his decision.

A claim in for the #3, “Kylie’s Cozy Kid,” by Auto Bhan Racing Stables Inc. – Ruben Monjes, was **“VOID”** as the claim was made in Auto Bahn Racing Inc., without the “Stables” included in the name, and Bhan being spelled incorrectly.
