FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m. #3, “Tiniebla,” was a Stewards scratch. #7, “Brooks Lass,” was claimed by Home Team Stables – Scott Lake. **INQUIRY AT THE THREE-EIGHTHS POLE –** Hold and claim of foul by Martin Solis, the rider of the #5, “Baby Butterscotch,” against the #7, “Brooks Lass,” and rider Erasmo Martinez, for coming over in front of him at the three-eighths pole, causing him to clip heels. After reviewing the video the Stewards determined that the #7 came in at the three-eighths pole, causing the #5 to clip his heels. The #7 was disqualified from 4th and placed 5th behind the #5 who was placed 4th.
