Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science revealed the following:

- Samples #50691 and #50733 from September 11, 2014, are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Samples #50671, #50680, #50703, #50720 and #50739 from September 13, 2014, are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

Administrative activities on Tuesday, September 23, 2014:

Two Assistant Trainer exams were given to Ms. Carolann McGee, a groom for trainer, Jonathan Sheppard and Mr. Gerardo Escobedo, a groom for trainer Jamie Ness. Both subject passed the written examination and will be issued certificates of completion.

We held a hearing today for trainer Juan Vazquez for failure to report his workout information to the Clocker. By rule, trainers are required to report horses names and distances worked so that the Clocker can correctly report this information to *Equibase* and the Daily Racing Form keeping the public informed. In the opinion of the Stewards, this matter has been resolved. Mr. Vazquez was issued a warning.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. #3, “Tahaddi,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Trumpet Kaz,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – Hold and claim of foul by David Ortiz, the rider of the #5, “Trumpet Kaz,” against Fray Martinez, the rider of the #6, “Love Undercover,” for coming over and pushing him in at the start. After reviewing the video the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official.
