The Stewards approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #2, “Star Destiny,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Sky Maggy,” and #6, “Hidden Blitz,” were scratched by their trainer due to track conditions. #7, “Eight Riders,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. #1, “Senor Quickie,” was claimed by Annette Eubanks – Owner Trainer. #1a, “Vindicated,” was claimed by Robert A. Derr – Timothy Kreiser. #3, “Big Blue Nation,” was claimed by Autobahn Racing Stables Inc. – Ruben Monjes. A claim in for the #1, “Senor Quickie,” by Jose Salud Rodriguez – Keli Peterson was **VOID** for insufficient funds in their horseman’s account. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The #1a, “Vindicated,” turned his head to the left just as the race started breaking slowly. After reviewing the video the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 – 2b - 3 – 1a - 5.” Starters – 5**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #2b, “Jarrod’s Commando,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Shimmy Tinjo,” was selected for a blood gas test. A claim in for the #5, “Rolling Yona,” by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness was **VOID** for insufficient funds in their horseman’s account. **ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 2 – 1a - 7.” Starters - 8**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. #4, “Miss Dayna Lee,” was claimed by June Thurston – Jerry Thurston. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The #7, “Thrill Show,” reared at the time the race started and hit the side of the gate breaking slowly. Mohamed Osman, the rider of the #5, “Deb’s Trip,” broke out of the gate pulling back on the reins to maintain his balance causing the horse to throw its head several times.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 1 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. The main track has been upgraded to **GOOD** starting this race. #1, “Righteous Intent,” #2, “Double Dinnermint,” #3, “Really Really,” #5, “Sandy the Bear,” #6, “Natetwa,” and #8, “Alva Lena,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #9, “Daddy’s Truth,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 11 - 7 - 12.” Starters - 6

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. #2, “Play Pretty,” and #5, “All D’ Night,” were vet scratches. #4, “Maximus Marcus,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta, wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 5

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. Fray Martinez, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Just Irish,” was changed to Joshua Navarro; no double jocks mount. #8, “How Cool Is He,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Opportunistically,” #9, “Track Telling,” and #11, “Legal Buzz,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #12, “I’m Not Who I Was,” and #14, “Satch,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. #7, “Our Niece,” was selected for a blood gas test. A Claim in for the #5, “Devil’s Blush,” by Lorna L. Baker – Thomas H. Michaels Jr. was **VOID** as the claim blank was signed by the trainer and not the owner.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 8 - 1.” Starters - 8

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m. **INQUIRY AT THE TOP OF THE STRETCH** – Hold and claim of foul by Laura Carson, the rider of the #1, “Dream Machine,” against Gregorio Rivera, the rider of the #5, “Southerland,” for coming in and taking her room away at the top of the stretch. After reviewing the video, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. #6, “BR Dance In Red,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Southerland,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta, wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.
