Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE QUARTER POLE – Hold and claim of foul by Mohamed Osman, the rider of #2 “Robin’s Kisses,” against Martin Solis, the rider of the #1, “Jill’s Image,” for coming in at the quarter pole impeding his horse. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #1 came in impeding the #2. The #1 was disqualified from 3rd and placed 5th behind the #2 who was placed 4th for interference at the quarter pole.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. Scott Spieth, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Eight Riders,” was changed to Julio Mera; no double jocks mount. #5, “Socialsaul,” was scratched by the racing office.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 8 - 3.” Starters - 7

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. #3, “Lust for Diamonds,” and #8, “Have a Taste,” were vet scratches.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 6

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE FIVE- EIGHTHS POLE - #3, “Miss Andorra,” ridden by Fray Martinez ran up closely behind jockey Tyler Conner’s mount, the #6, North Light Lady” clipping heels. The Stewards did not take any action regarding placing in this race, however, the riders involved will be present for film review on Saturday to discuss safe race riding practices. #1a, “Foxy Drummer,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Keypartner,” was selected for a blood gas test.

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:53 p.m. #2, “Pure Genius,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Harley’s Joy,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Lex’s Candel,” was scratched by Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts, for not warming up well in the post parade. #10, “Our Lucky Lady,” was claimed by Triple R. Stable – Rodolfo Romero.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 5 - 9.” Starters - 7

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:53 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH – Hold and claim of foul by Ricardo Chiappe, the rider of #5 “Brothersofthetime,” against Carol Ceden, the rider of the #8, “Castaway,” for coming in during the stretch run, impeding his horse. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined there was insufficient cause to take any action and made the race official. #2, Bobby J’s Rush,” #3, “Jessethemarine,” #4, “IL Villano,” and #6, “Picko’s Pride,” were vet scratches. #5, “Brothersofthetime,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.
