Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

Post-race test results from L.G.C. Science revealed the following:

- All Samples, from Wednesday, October 8, 2014, were clear.
- All Samples, from Thursday, October 9, 2014, were clear.
- A certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #44809 which was collected from the horse “Rock Slide Johnny,” who ran in the 3<sup>rd</sup> race on Wednesday, July 9, 2014, contained “Dexamethasone” in the amount of 33 picograms per milliliter of plasma; the sample also contained Testosterone and Nandrolone, which is indicative of a ridgling not a gelding. As a result of the positive test, inspection of the barn and tack rooms assigned to trainer, Juan Vazquez, revealed no medications. Subsequently, trainer Vazquez contacted the Stewards, stating that he would exercise his right to a split sample.
- A certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #50575 which was collected from the horse, “Target Sighted,” who ran in the 2<sup>nd</sup> race on Monday, August 25, 2014, contained “Phenylbutazone” in the amount of 3.7 micrograms per milliliter of plasma. The trainer of this horse, Thomas Iannotti IV, was informed of this matter by the Stewards.
- A certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #50582 which was collected from the horse, “Kay’s Finesse,” who ran in the 1<sup>st</sup> race on Wednesday, August 27, 2014, contained “Clenbuterol” in the amount of 226 picograms per milliliter of urine. The trainer of this horse, Todd Beattie, was informed of this matter by the Stewards.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m.** #1, “Twenty Black,” #3, “Brooks Lass,” and #4, “Banner Elk Lady,” were vet scratches. We canceled Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Place and Show wagering for this race as we were below four betting interests.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 3**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m.** The #2, “Hot Rod Lincoln,” was a late scratch by the Stewards, as its rider Martin Solis, did not like the way the horse was acting during the post parade, and did not want to ride the horse. We could not find another rider that would ride the horse. #5, “Road to Hope,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 6**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m.** Michael Ritvo, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Faithful Servant,” was changed to Tyler Conner; no double jocks mount. **INQUIRY AT THE QUARTER POLE –** Hold and claim of foul by Juan Torres, the rider of #4 “Strait Smile,” against Ricardo Chiappe, the rider of the #7, “El Chaparro,” for coming in at the quarter pole impeding his horse. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #2, “Irish Donnie,” with rider Fray Martinez came out, forcing the #4 to go out and bump the #7 at the quarter pole. As the #4 had beaten the #2 no action was taken by the Stewards. #2, “Irish Donnie,” broke down at the quarter pole and was pulled up lame at the finish line. The #2 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner who informed the Stewards the #2 had injured its right front knee. Dr. Teichner requested the horse ambulance transport the equine to its stall. The rider Fray Martinez was not injured, as he had dismounted the horse without mishap.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 7 - 6 – 1a - 4.” Starters - 8**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m.** After a two-way shake, #3, “Drain,” was claimed by Worcester Investments LLC – Henry Worcester IV. #7, “Champion Sound,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 7**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE START -** #5, “Sumo,” broke outwardly at the start, bumping the #6, “Armi Base,”. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. #1a, “Deployingresources,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #6, “Armi Base,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 7**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m.** Tyler Conner, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Tiznow True,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. #6, “Sons of Missouri,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Tiznow True,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3, “Make Me a Deal,” was claimed by Larry Rabold – Shellaine Brown.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 6**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m.** Hold and claim of foul by Michael Ritvo the rider of #2, “Kearney Square,” against Ricardo Chiappe, the rider of the #7, “Hiram,” for coming in during the stretch run, impeding his horse. After reviewing the video, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action. No inquiry was called in this race. #4, “Golden Rings,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 7 - 2 - 1.” Starters - 7**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:49 p.m.** Carlos Luis Gutierrez, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Stray Bullet,” was changed to Juan Torres; no double jocks mount. #5, “Sweet Maxine,” was claimed by Jose Gutierrez – James P. Conner III
