FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m. #4, “Evil Lad,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Toco Boy,” was selected for a blood gas test. #1, “More Than Likely,” was claimed by Robert L. Cole Jr. – Scott Lake.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 6

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. David Cora the scheduled rider on the #4, “Soniko (ARG),” was changed to Angel Serpa; no double jocks mount. Jomar Ortega the scheduled rider on the #6, “Tremont Street,” was changed to Juan Torres; no double jocks mount. #1, “Salem Harbor,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The #6, “Tremont Street,” dwelt at the start refusing to break. The starter, Robert Sydnor is barring the #6 from future racing. The #5, “Sharp Silence,” broke slowly. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 3 – 1a.” Starters - 9

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m. . #1, “Home of America,” was scratched by the racing office. #7, “Clowns to the Left,” was selected for a blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START** – The #4, “North Light Lady,” lost her action the second jump out of the gate, unseating apprentice jockey, Mohamed Osman. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. Apprentice jockey Osman requested to be transported to the hospital for further evaluation. Just after the ninth race we called first aid again, and EMT Mike Cooper said the rider had changed his mind and did not want to be transported to the hospital. After being examined by EMT Mike Cooper Mr. Osman signed a refusal of treatment form, returning to the jockey’s quarters

After a three-way shake, #2, “Longer Terms Doug,” was claimed by Manfred Roos and John Rigattieri - John Rigattieri.

After reviewing the video, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. Clinton Potts, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Royal Marine,” was changed to Angel Serpa; no double jocks mount. #5, “Lefty Got It Right,” was selected for a blood gas test.
