Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

We conducted a hearing this morning for Jockeys Angel Serpa and Trevor McCarthy, concerning an altercation in the jockeys quarters, following the running of the fifth race on Saturday, July 5, 2014. It was the decision of the Stewards to fine Mr. Serpa, \$250.00 and require him to enter and complete an anger management program.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH – The rider of the #3, Cherokee Creek,” Vince Halliday, put the race on hold and claimed foul in the stretch against the #5, “Champion Sound,” with rider Carol Cedeno. After reviewing the video, the Stewards determined that the #5 came out twice in the stretch, bumping the #3. The Stewards disqualified the #5 from first and placed her second behind the #3 who was moved up to first. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. #3, “Mountain Sprite,” and #7, “Baby Situation,” were scratched as main-track only. #6, “Queenofzeenile,” was claimed by Steeplechase Farm – Michael Gorham. **INQUIRY AT THE THREE-EIGHTHS POLE –** #5, “Our Deputy Express,” ridden by Ricardo Chiappe, broke down at the three-eighths pole. The injured horse was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown. Following examination by Dr. Brown, he determined that the horse suffered a fracture to its right front ankle. Due to the injury, “Our Deputy Express” was humanely destroyed. Jockey, Ricardo Chiappe who had been unseated in the accident, was transported to first aid. It was later reported by EMT Antonio Morales, that Mr. Chiappe did not sustain any injury as a result of the incident, and signed a refusal of treatment form to continue riding. **ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 2 - 6 - 10.” Starters – 10**

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m. Fray Martinez, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Brooks Lass,” was changed to Erasmo Martinez; double jocks mount will be charged. Ricardo Chiappe, the scheduled rider on the #4, “Lady Marian Louise,” was changed to Carol Ceden; no double jocks mount. #1, “Orange’s Lil Sis,” was a vet scratch. #3, “Ava Again,” was selected for a blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race, as we were below six betting interests. **ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 5**

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:51 p.m. #2, “Cheypooter,” was scratched as a main-track only. #13, “Violet Road,” was scratched as an alternate. #10, “Nour Iayoun,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 9 - 5 - 12.” Starters - 11**

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:22 p.m. #2, “Quick Bid,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Age of Aquarius,” was selected for a blood gas test. #3, “Flashy Eyed Pearl,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #3, “Flashy Eyed Pearl,” requested a \$140.00 all inclusive special test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 7 - 5.” Starters - 6**

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - THE NICK SHUK MEMORIAL STAKES - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:53 p.m. #4, “Open the Bank,” #6, “Solemnly Swear,” #8, “Condo Closing,” and #9, “Joint Custody,” were scratched in compliance with stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #3, “Ride Away,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 1 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 7**
