Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE START – Hold and claim of foul by the #4, “Maximus Marcus,” with rider Brian Pedroza against the #5, “Double Prophecy,” and rider Ricardo Chiappe, for coming in at the start, causing him to take up on his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. #4, “Maximus Marcus,” was selected for a special post-race test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:49 p.m. Trevor McCarthy, the scheduled rider on the #2, “My Pioneer,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. #4, “Not for Grace,” #9, “Mo Didn’t Know,” and #10, “Thessa’s Roar,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #1, “Cynthia’s New Car,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 11 - 3 - 7.” Starters - 8

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 6

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #5, “Positivo,” stumbled at the start. #3, “Pie Baby Pie,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 3 - 6.” Starters - 6

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m. #6, “Gator Gone Wild,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:47 p.m. #4, “Ima Big Colta,” was a vet scratch. #1, “Learaig (IRE),” #5, “Natorious Zapper,” and #9, “Spartianos,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 8 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 5

SEVENTH RACE –POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. Hold and claim of foul by the #1, “Pea Shooter Pro,” with rider Alex Cintron against the #4, “Centering,” with rider Daniel Centeno, for coming out in front of him nearing the finish causing him to have to check his mount. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. No Inquiry was called by the Stewards in this race. #1, “Pea Shooter Pro,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 1 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 7

EIGHTH RACE – THE OUR MIMS STAKES - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:00 p.m. Kendrick Carmouche, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Milaya,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. #5, “Embellish the Lace,” and #10, “Sweet On Smokey,” were scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #8, “White Clover,” was selected for a blood gas test. We experienced a 12 minute delay in the start of this race as the #7, Catcha Rising Star,” flipped in the starting gate injured itself and was scratched by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner. The rider of the #7, “Catcha Rising Star,” Julian Pimentel was transported to the hospital for observation, after complaining of neck, back, and hip pain.

ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 9 - 1 - 6.” Starters - 8

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:28 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:30 p.m. #7, “Culous Way,” was scratched due to track conditions. #5, “Quay to Heaven,” was selected for a blood gas test.
