Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Samples from May 27, 2015 are clear.
- Twenty five Out of Competition Testing samples from May 2015 are clear. We are waiting on the other five out of competition samples that were sent to Truesdail Laboratories, Inc.
- Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #14260, taken from the horse “Miss Dayna Lee” which ran in the 5th race on Saturday, May 23, 2015, contained “Dexamethasone,” in the amount of 33 picograms per milliliter of plasma. The trainer of record, Jerry Thurston, was informed of the laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector’s Swift and Delaney conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Thurston’s assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed no prohibited items. Mr. Thurston waived his rights to a split sample and a hearing in this matter, accepting a fine of Five Hundred dollars for this violation.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:18p.m. #1, “Empress Hatshepsut,” was claimed by Tigertail Ranch – Steve Krebs. #1, “Empress Hatshepsut,” was selected for a blood gas test. We encountered an 18 minute tote delay in making this race official. This was due to a refund when one of the betting hubs went down.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:50 p.m.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:20 p.m. After a two-way shake, #4, “Cause for Victory,” was claimed by Bruno Schickendanz – Aldana Gonzalez. #7, “Middletown Gal,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 5 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:52 p.m.
This race was scheduled at seven and one half furlongs on the turf, but ran at one mile on the main track. #1, “Why Not Be Queen,” #6, “Where’s the Risk,” and #7, “Amazing Anthem,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #4, “Con Gee,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 5 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 7

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:24 p.m. #4, “Sparks to Flame,” was scratched by its trainer. #9, “East Bound Train,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #2, “Unusual Don,” was selected for a blood gas test. #6, “Aly’s Gatto,” turned his head at the break, breaking slowly.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:53 p.m.
Matthew Rispoli, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Wasatch,” was changed to Kerwin Clark; no double jocks mount. #3, “Juliet Alpha,” #4, “Saint Abbey,” #5, “Broken Halo,” #6, “Curlish Figure,” #9, “Tap Shoes,” and #11, “Port Charlotte,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #14, “Sweet Maya,” was scratched as an alternate. #1, “Wasatch,” was selected for a blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 8 - 13.” Starters - 7

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:25 p.m. #1a, “Warrensburg,” and #2, “Fantasmagorico,” were scratched as part of same-owner entries. #7, “Anybodyreallyknow,” was a vet scratch. #1. **INQUIRY IN DEEP STRETCH** – Hold and Claim of foul by #3, “Disarm,” with rider Maria Remedio against the #4, “Doddsprivatelabel,” ridden by Larry Mejias, for coming in and bumping her horse before the finish. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the #4, “Doddsprivatelabel,” was disqualified from first and placed second behind the #3, “Disarm,” who was moved up to first. “Everybody’s Daddy,” was selected for a special post-race test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 – 2b - 1.” Starters - 6

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:54 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:55 p.m. Robert Paz, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Sergeant Pepper MHF,” was changed to Juan Torres; double jocks mount will be charged. #6, “RB Rich Kin,” was a vet scratch.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 – 1a - 4 - 3.” Starters - 6
