Steward, Jack Houghton Jr. attended a meeting with Truesdail Laboratory representatives, and the Delaware Racing Commission, to discuss laboratory procedures, including test result reporting.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #6, “Mastic,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #1, “Tough N Trashy,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #2, “Gentlemen’s Nick,” and #4, “Hurricane Creek,” were vet scratches. #7, “Indiana Moon,” was scratched by its trainer. #6, “Holiday Boy,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #3, “Pio’s Passion,” and #11, “Quarterback Sneak,” were selected for a special post-race testing.

Jordan,” was changed to Erik Barbaran; no double jocks mount. Yomar Orlando Ortiz, scheduled to ride #9, “Scrapple,” was changed to Xavier Perez; no double jocks mount. #1, “Mr. Rover,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Here’s to Mike,” #7, “El Chivo,” #10, “Hill Tie,” and #11, “Smart Power,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #13, “Wally Did It,” was scratched as an alternate. #6, “A. V. Jordan,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

Angel Castillo, the scheduled rider on the #5, “Awe Zoom,” was changed to Andry Blanco; no double jocks mount. #1, “Sweet Sandy,” #2, “Intrepid Alex,” #3, “Euphonic,” #4, “Pauline’s Pride,” #7, “Ascot Girl,” #9, “Split It,” and #10, “Inside Out,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. We canceled Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Place and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:46 p.m. Taylor Hole, scheduled to ride #8, “Dr Bolt,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. Carol Ceden, the scheduled rider on the #1a, “Today’s Man,” was changed to Angel Serpa; no double jocks mount. #1, “Warrensburg,” and #1a, “Today’s Man,” were selected for special post-race testing.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 7 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 9

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:21 p.m. #8, “Miss Turbina,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. The #6, “Minerva Love,” was scratched by Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, as the horse had flipped in the gate injuring itself. The rider of the #6 Keiber Coa was not injured, as he had gotten off the horse before it flipped. The #4, “Callmebelladonna,” walked out of the gate breaking slowly. #7, “Congratulatory,” was selected for a special post-race test. #2, “Noticia,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
