



## Daily Log Stewards Report Delaware Park

Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

### Administrative Hearings:

A hearing was held on Monday June 8, 2015 for trainer Mr. Todd Beattie concerning his "Clenbuterol," positive, for the horse "Kay's Finesse," who had finished first in the first race on Wednesday, August 27, 2014. Mr. Beattie having appeared for a Stewards hearing, was issued a seven-day suspension and \$500.00 fine. The horse "Kay's Finesse" will be disqualified from all purse monies, from the first race on Wednesday, August 27, 2014. Mr. Beattie has indicated that he will appeal the Stewards decision to the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission.

### Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Samples #14924, and #14938 collected on May 30, 2015, are on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- All Samples from June 1, 2015 are clear.
- The remaining five out of competition samples from May 2015 are clear.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH** – The #1, "Salsamon," broke out at the start. The #8, "Shayenut'ntonoby," ridden by Carole Cedeno, broke down in the stretch. The injured horse was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner. Following examination by Dr. Teichner, she determined that the horse suffered a fracture to its left front cannon bone. Due to the catastrophic nature of the injury, the horse had to be humanely destroyed. Jockey, Carol Cedeno who had been unseated in the accident, reported to first aid. It was later reported by EMT Mike Cooper, that Ms. Cedeno did not sustain any injury as a result of the incident, and signed a refusal of treatment form to continue riding.

**SECOND RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.** #3, “Over the Cliff,” was pulled up after the race at the seven-eighths pole with the rider Keiber Coa getting off. The #3 was examined by Dr. Teichner, who could find nothing wrong with the horse. Frankie Pennington, the scheduled rider on the #13, “Littlemissperfect,” was changed to Jorge A. Vega Jr.; no double jocks mount. Carol Cedeno, scheduled to ride the #8, “Edyanne,” was changed to Maria Remedio.; no double jocks mount. #1, “Moral High Ground,” #4, “Pleasant McGee,” #5, “Heaven Help Me,” #7, “Her Royalship,” #9, “Take It Inside,” #10, “Racyn With Gracyn,” and #11, “Noor Un Nisa,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #8, “Edyanne,” was selected for special post-race testing.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “13 - 8 - 12 - 3.” Starters - 6**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m.** #1a, “Coldblack,” and #2, “Amber Coast,” were scratched as part of same-owner entries. #6, “Vinny’s Wildcat,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #7, “Peaceadaaction,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 3 - 7 – 2b.” Starters - 6**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m.** #3, “Skestos,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 8 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 8**

**FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - THE JUSTAKISS STAKES (Div.) - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m.** #7, “Brenda’s Way,” #9, “Granny Mc’s Kitten,” and #12, “Camille Claudel,” were scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #5, “Party Starter,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 1 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 10**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH –** The #3, “Frosty Majesty,” ridden by Jorge Luis Vergara, fell in the stretch. The injured horse was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown. Following examination by Dr. Brown, the #3, “Frosty Majesty,” was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. Due to the catastrophic nature of the injury, the horse had to be humanely destroyed. Jockey, Jorge Luis Vergara who had been unseated in the accident, reported to first aid. It was later reported by EMT Mike Cooper, that Mr. Vergara did not sustain any injury as a result of the incident, signing a refusal of treatment form, returning to the jockey’s quarters.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 7**

**SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - THE JUSTAKISS STAKES (Div.) - POST TIME – 4:30 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:34 p.m.** We encountered a 12 minute delay in the post time for this race, as we had to transport the fallen horse from the previous race off the racing surface. #4, “Luna Time,” #5, “Buttercup Bay,” and #8, “Who’s In Town,” were scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #2, “Latique,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “13 - 2 - 10 - 9.” Starters - 10**
