Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Samples #14924 and #14938 which were placed on hold from May 30, 2015, are now clear.
- All Samples from June 2, and June 3, 2015 are clear.
- Workout samples #15034 for May 6, #14981 for May 7, and #14992 for May 8, 2015 are all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #7, “Madre Ditutticapi,” pulled up sore after the race at the seven furlong marker. The #7 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, who said the horse was sore in the left front ankle. The horse was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. #2, “Galpal,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 1 - 2.” Starters - 7

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #1, “Cashondabarrelhead,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #2, “Dream of Pegasus,” pulled up sore after the race at the seven furlong marker. The #2 was examined by Dr. Brown, who advised that the horse was sore in the left front ankle. “DREAM OF PEGASUS” was thereafter transported from the racing surface via horse ambulance. #4, “African Jewel” and #6, “Distortedredhead,” were vet scratches. #7, “Raising Passion,” and #11, “Twisted Gal,” were scratched by their trainers. #13, “Our Niece,” was scratched as an alternate.

ORDER OF FINISH – “12 - 10 - 8 - 5.” Starters – 8

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #2, “Extreme Alex,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #1, “Levantemo,” #4, “Missy’s Heir,” and #5, “Tickled Blue,” were vet scratches. #7, “Summer Morn,” was claimed by Timothy F. Richey Racing Stables Inc. – Timothy F. Richey. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 4

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. Jockey Juan Torres, scheduled to ride the #4, “Wendy Wend,” was changed to Martin Solis; double jocks mount will be charged. #8, “I’m too hot to handle,” was a vet scratch.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 8

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:19 p.m. Taylor Hole, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Wowwhatabrat,” was changed to Carol Ceden; no double jocks mount. #8, “Mastic,” was scratched as a main-track only. #11, “Smuggling,” #12, “Lovingly,” #13, “Steelaway Lady,” and #14, “Summer’s Here,” were scratched as alternates.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 9

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m. #4, “Niccataasha,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. Jockey Julian Pimintel scheduled to ride the #5, “Stylish Step,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. #5, “Stylish Step,” was claimed by John Grossi’s Racing Corp. – William Downing. The owner and trainer that claimed the #5, “Stylish Step,” requested a \$113.00 all inclusive special test. #8, “She’s a tree hugger,” stumbled at the start.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m. Jockey Josean Ramirez, the scheduled rider on the #3, “Incisive Strike,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. #1, “Cruise More,” #4, “Heroic Royal,” #8, “Mr J,” #11, “Ez Mac,” and #12, “Cut to Order,” were vet scratches. #6, “Piano Man Ted,” was scratched by the Stewards for failure of the trainer to have the horse’s foal certificate on file. #5, “Winding Road,” was scratched as a main-track only.

ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 3 - 7 - 9.” Starters - 5

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:49 p.m. The scheduled rider on the #4, “Golden Rings,” Michael Ritvo, was changed to J. Christian Navarro; no double jocks mount. #2, “Hiram,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. **Hold and claim of foul** by the trainer of the #4, Golden Rings,” Juan Vazquez against the #3, “I’m Steppin’ It Up,” with rider Alex Cintron, for coming out at the top of the stretch causing his horse to alter course. After talking to both riders involved, and reviewing the films the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. It was noted that no inquiry by the Stewards, or claim of foul by the rider of the #4 J. Christian Navarro, was lodged into the running of this race. #4, “Golden Rings,” was selected for special post-race testing.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 4 – 1a.” Starters - 7

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:20 p.m. #1, “Noon Shadow,” and #5, “Vanna Go’s Point,” were scratched by their trainers. #3, “I’myoursugardaddy,” was claimed by Home Team Stable – Steve Krebs. A claim in for the #6, “Do Ya Wanna,” by Jose Serrano – James Tsirigotis Sr. was **VOID** for a lack of money in their horsemen’s account. #7, “Techwood,” hopped out of the starting gate, breaking slowly.
