Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Mr. Todd Beattie called the Stewards this morning, stating that he will not appeal the Stewards ruling (11-2015) issued on June 9, 2015. The ruling was issued for his “Clenbuterol,” positive, concerning the horse “Kay’s Finesse,” which was reported by L.G.C. Science Inc. on October 16, 2015. Mr. Beattie’s seven day suspension will start on Wednesday, June 17, 2015.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Dad’s Glad,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. **INQUIRY AT THE START – #1, “Dad’s Glad,”** broke into the side of gate at the start, breaking slowly. The #2, “Pavlick” broke in at the start, filling the void left by the #1 as he also broke slowly. Jockey Victor Carrero, the scheduled rider of the #2, “Pavlick,” was changed to Xavier Perez; no double jocks mount. **ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 6**

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.
INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH – The #7, “Dipping Diamonds,” ridden by Scott Spieth, broke down in the stretch. The injured horse was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown. Following examination by Dr. Brown, the #7, “Dipping Diamonds,” was humanely destroyed due to suffering a catastrophic injury. Jockey, Scott Spieth who had been unseated during the incident, reported to first aid. It was later reported by EMT Mike Cooper, that Mr. Spieth had pain in his left ankle. At his request, Mr. Spieth was excused from his remaining mounts on the card.
ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 7

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #9, “Commersant,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #2, “Blimey,” was scratched on account of track conditions. #10, “Jazzysdudeaintrude,” was a vet scratch.
ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 6 - 9 - 4.” Starters - 8

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:47 p.m. #1, “Italian Delight,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. Taylor Hole, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Italian Delight,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. Michael Ritvo, scheduled to ride the #4, “Miss Amalitat,” was changed to Maria Remedio; no double jocks mount. Scott Spieth, who was scheduled to ride the #6, “Terry Blossom,” was changed to Carol Ceden; no double jocks mount.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 7

FIFTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. #4, “Opio,” was scratched by the Stewards, as trainer Thomas Michaels reported that persons unknown had removed both front shoes from his horse. The Commission inspectors were called to investigate the complaint. The #1, “Spirit in the Nite,” #5, “Book the Bet,” #7, “Our Lukester,” #8, “Master Zeus,” and #10, “Barton Holt,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #11, “Step Two,” #12, “Ocala Rush,” and #13, “Hauler,” were scratched as alternates. This race was scheduled at seven and one half furlongs on the turf, but ran at one mile on the main track. **INQUIRY IN DEEP STRETCH** – Hold and Claim of foul by #14, “Current Rate,” with rider Victor Carrasco against the #3, “Freelander,” with rider Xavier Perez, for coming out and bumping his horse before the finish. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 14 - 2 - 6.” Starters - 5

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m. #1, “Man of Mystery,” was getting out real bad on the turn.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 6

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF – 4:16 p.m. #1, “Other Cheek,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Messi (GER),” #5, “Soup d’Coupe,” #6, “Iconic Artist,” #7, “Bishop’s Castle,” #8, “Tru Greek,” and #9 Maserati (BRZ),” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. We canceled Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Place and Show wagering for this race as we were below four betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 4 – 1a.” Starters - 3

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:45 p.m. #1, “Kholberg,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. Scott Spieth, schedule to ride the #2, “Royal L. S.,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 7
