Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #6, “Faithful Servant,” was a vet scratch. After a two-way shake, #1, “Around We Go,” was claimed by Home Team Stables – Steve Krebs. #3, “Majestic Number,” was claimed by Flying V. Stable – Brooke Braithaupt.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 1 - 3.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #3, “Ida the Fox,” and #4, “Best Number,” were vet scratches. #6, “Doc of the Court,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 8 – 1a - 2.” Starters - 7

THIRD RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. The turf races were called off at 2:00 p.m. fifteen minutes prior to post time for this race, as heavy rains started at 1:45 p.m. The main track was downgraded to **SLOPPY** starting with this race. The apprentice weight claimed on the #8, “New Dude,” was removed, as the rider Jorge L. Vargas Jr. is no longer an apprentice; the weight was changed from 114 with a seven pound apprentice allowance to 121 with no apprentice allowance. #6, “Rodeado,” and #11, “Pro Daddy,” were scratched as main-track only. #12, “Hardwired,” was scratched as an alternate. #5, “Coraggio,” broke slowly.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 13 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 11

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. #1, “Celebratemehome,” was scratched on account for track conditions. #5, “Mastic,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 5

FIFTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m. Trevor McCarthy, the scheduled rider on the #9, “East of Danzig,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. #2, “Professor Palmer,” was scratched by the Stewards, as the horse was ineligible for the race conditions. The racing office had overwritten the computer system to allow this horse to enter the race. #3, “Photogenic,” and #10, “Dr. Wesley,” were scratched as main-track only. #13, “Franklin,” and #14, “Big Johnny D (IRE),” were scratched as alternates. #5, “East Indies,” and #6, “Scrapple,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf.

ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 4 - 7 - 12.” Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:50 p.m. #1, “American Ransom,” was a vet scratch. Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner recommended to the Stewards that the #9, “D K Edge,” be scratched as the horse had a loose right hind shoe.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 2 - 3.” Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m. Ryan Barber, the scheduled rider on the #10, “Lady From Cheyenne,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. #3, “Devil’s Holiday,” was a vet scratch. #11, “Sizzling Lassie,” and #12, “Bilyscrystalball,” were scratched as alternates. #4, “Right Or Wrong,” #7, “Stormy Salute,” and #9, “Why Not Be Queen,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #10, “Lady From Cheyenne,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 2 - 8 - 6.” Starters - 6

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m. Nik Juarez, the scheduled rider on the #1, “Anythingicandoforu,” was changed to Christian Navarro; no double jocks mount. Trevor McCarthy, scheduled to ride #5, “Princess Emma Rose,” was changed to Scott Spieth; no double jocks mount. #2, “Sunny Maria,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Miss Mandalay,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 5 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 5

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:16 p.m. Trevor McCarthy, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Minor Crisis,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. Erik Barbaran, scheduled to ride #5, “Seriously Simon,” was changed to Mario Rodriguez; no double jocks mount. Alex Cortez, the scheduled rider on the #8, “Fairway King,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. #7, “Quay to Heaven,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #2, “Minor Crisis,” was claimed by Happy Hour Stable LLC – William Morey. #2, “Minor Crisis,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
