### Administrative Hearings:

Assistant Trainer, Mr. Frank Trombley, who had tested positive for marijuana, on Tuesday, May, 26, 2015, was reinstated with a conditional license upon recommendation from the horsemen's Drug and Alcohol counselor, Ms. Nan Freeman. Mr. Trombley must comply with all conditions set forth in the ruling issued by the Stewards.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m.** #5, "Play Me Now," was a vet scratch. #7, "I Do Not Know," was selected for special post-race testing.

**ORDER OF FINISH – "4 - 6 - 2 - 1." Starters - 7**

**SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:49 p.m.** #6, "Rail Stop," was scratched by its trainer. #11, "Cross Match," #12, "Senora Quatorze," #13, "Holy Scat," and #14, "Total Destiny," were scratched as alternates.

**ORDER OF FINISH – "5 - 4 - 9 - 3." Starters - 9**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m.** Laura Glaser, scheduled to ride #2, "Colton's Honor," was changed to Narcisco Cruz; no double jocks mount. #9, "Dardanian," was a vet scratch. #1, "Single Origin," was selected for special post-race testing. #6, "The Five Points," was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #7, "Barbada," ridden by Erik Barbaran, was pulled up by its rider at the ¼ pole and then dismounted. The #7 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who said the horse was off in the right front. Subsequently, "Barbada" was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. *After the fourth race, Dr. Teichner reported that "Barbada," had suffered a right front condylar fracture, and was humanely destroyed.*

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:53 p.m.** Michael Ritvo, scheduled to ride #2, “I’m Really Sumthin,” was changed to Andry Blanco; no double jocks mount. #10, “Smarty Star,” #11, “Cocoa Bandita,” #12, “Smuggling,” #13, “Hurricane Bluff Dr,” and #14, “Pleasant Wind,” were scratched as alternates. #1, “She’s Overwelming,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #3, “Blame It On Ed,” was claimed by Gumpster Stable – Jamie Ness. The Owner and Trainer that claimed the #3, “Blame It On Ed,” requested a \$113.00 all inclusive special test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 9**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:22 p.m.** #5, “Trip Six,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #3, “Fantasmagorico,” was selected for special post-race testing. #6, “Maybrys Challenge,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #3, “Fantasmagorico,” was claimed by Wayne Potts – Owner Trainer.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 1 - 8.” Starters - 7**

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:52 p.m.** Carlos Castro scheduled to ride #4, “Arion Silver,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. Mario Remedio, the scheduled rider on the #7, “Karfagen,” was changed to Josue Arce; no double jocks mount. #1a, “Agonistic,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry and alternate. #8, “Heza Fox,” was scratched as a main-track only.

**DURING THE RACE:** This race was placed on hold by Inoel Beato, the rider of the #2, “Perfect Trip, for trouble at the three-eighths pole. We interviewed jockey Beato but he could not identify who to claim foul against. Following a review of the films of the race, we saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. It is noted that there was no Inquiry by the Stewards nor a claim of foul lodged in this race.

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:23 p.m.** #4, “We B Jammin,” was scratched by its trainer. #2, “Strike Em Down,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #5, “Indy Strike,” was selected for special post-race testing.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 8**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:51 p.m.** #5, “Heaven’s Runway,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #2, “Awesome Devine,” was selected for special post-race testing.

**NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:19 p.m.** #2, “Starship Gambler,” #6, “Queen Yamile,” and #7, “Our Tigress,” were vet scratches. #4, “Gold Potion,” was selected for special post-race testing. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests. 4, “Gold Potion,” ridden by Scott Spieth, was pulled up at the 5/16 pole where the rider dismounted. The #4 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who said she could not see anything wrong with the horse. The horse was subsequently removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. #1, “Miss Dayna Lee,” was claimed by June Thurston – Jerry Thurston.
