Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

### Administrative:

On Tuesday, June 23, 2015 two assistant trainer's tests were issued, one to Groom Mr. Diego Monjes and one to Exercise Rider Ms. Erin Wilkinson, Mr. Monjes and Ms. Wilkinson's tests will be graded by the Stewards as soon as possible.

Also on Tuesday, June 23, 2015 a trainers test was issued to Stable Foreman, Pedro Nazario. Mr. Nazario's test will be graded by the Stewards as soon as possible.

We held a hearing this morning for assistant trainer, Matthew Hartman. The hearing for Mr. Hartman was for reckless operation of a vehicle in the stable area causing damage to Delaware Park property. As a result of the hearing, Mr. Hartman will be required to pay all damages incurred as a result of the accident and will lose his driving privileges in the stable area for a period of thirty days.

Tammi Piermarini scheduled to ride #6, "Pick the Double," was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #3, "Edyanne," was selected for special post-race testing. #4, "Littlemissperfect," was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

**FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m.** Xavier Perez, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Reid the News,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. #1 “Uncle Tito,” #4, “The Great Provider,” #5, “Dune Dancer,” #6, “Spartianos,” and #11, “Learaig (IRE),” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 8 - 3 - 9.” Starters - 6**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:16 p.m.** #7, “Miss Al Capote,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #3, “Soul Spinner,” was a vet scratch. #9, “Loan Guarantee,” was scratched by the Stewards as the horse was ineligible due to being claimed at Parx Racing and the horse’s penalty days had not been completed. #6, “Madonna’s Conquest,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “12 - 2 - 5 - 11.” Starters - 9**

**SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:46 p.m.** Jorge Calderon, scheduled to ride #9, “Mizz Martha,” was changed to Augusto Marin; no double jocks mount. #3, “Countess Emma,” #4, “Billyscryystalball,” #5, “Smart N Smokin,” #6, “Rubiesandwranglers,” #8, “Sunflare,” and 10, “Sizzling Lassie,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. **DURING THE RACE: Hold and claim of foul** by trainer M.C. Reardon and jockey Augusto Marin of the #9, “Mizz Martha,” against #7 “Why Not Be Queen,” with rider Garry Cruise and the #1, “Banner Elk Lady,” with rider, Carol Cedeno, for coming out at the top of the stretch, causing him to steady his horse. The #7 “Why Not Be Queen,” with rider Garry Cruise, also claimed foul against the #1, “Banner Elk Lady,” with rider Carol Cedeno, for coming out at the top of the stretch, causing him to steady his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. No Inquiry by the Stewards was called into the running of this race. #1 “Banner Elk Lady,” was selected for special post-race testing. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 7 - 9.” Starters - 4**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:18 p.m.** Andrew Wolfsont scheduled to ride #3, “Small Giant,” was changed to Julio Hernandez; no double jocks mount. #1, “Jarrod’s Commando,” and #2, “Great Aztec,” were scratched as part of same-owner entries. Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner recommended to the Stewards that the #4, “Northern Label,” be scratched, as the horse was not warming up well. Dr. Teichner said the horse was off in the right front. The rider of the #4, “Northern Label,” Daniel Centeno, called the stewards after the race stating that the veterinarian did not ask how the horse felt to him, that she just scratched the horse. The owner of the #4, “Northern Label,” also called wanting to know why the horse was scratched, it was explained to him that the Commission Veterinarian recommended the scratch, as she felt the horse was off in the right front. #6, “Longer Terms Doug,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
