Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

As previously reported on Tuesday, June 23, 2015, two assistant trainer's tests were administered. Groom, Mr. Diego Monjes did not score enough points on the exam and did not qualify for an Assistant Trainer's License. Exercise rider, Ms. Erin Wilkinson passed her test and will be issued a certificate of accomplishment for her assistant trainers license.

Furthermore, Stable Foreman, Pedro Nazario who took his Trainer's test on 6-23-15 passed the exam and will be issued a certificate of accomplishment for his efforts.

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. for samples collected on June 16 and June 17, 2015 were all clear.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #7, "Do Ya Wanna," was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – "1 - 7 - 6 - 2." Starters - 7

SECOND RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:03 p.m. This race was taken off the turf at 12:40 p.m. #5, "Northwest Passage," was a vet scratch. #6, "Sloneker's Star," was scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #12, "Slews Love," was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #13, "Fasque," and #14, "The Shawnee," were scratched as alternates. #7, "Media Express," with rider Ricardo Chiappe, flipped in the gate injuring itself according to Dr. Richard Brown, Commission Veterinarian. As the horses were reloading into the gate, the #2, "Personal Favorite," unseated its rider, Maria Remedio. This horse was scratched by the Stewards for being very unruly behind the gate. We received a call from EMT Mike Cooper who reported that Jockeys Chiappe and Remedio both signed waivers and will continue riding the rest of their mounts. We experienced an 18 minute delay in the start of this race due to the two late scratches.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:31 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:33 p.m. Ricardo Chiappe, scheduled to ride #3, “Sweet Kateri,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. #1, “Prospecting Road,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Redworrioreess,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Holiday Wishes,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 6 - 3 - 4.” Starters - 5

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:00 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:01 p.m. #2, “Artie’s Flight,” #6, “Ari Mygypsyking,” and #8, “Corinthian Summer,” were scratched due to this race was taken off the turf. #12, “Profound,” was scratched as an alternate. #9, “Sweet Visionary,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 10 - 9.” Starters - 8

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:28 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:29 p.m. The main track has been downgraded to MUDDY starting with this race. Mario Rodriguez scheduled to ride #5, “Lake Creek,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. Hold by the owner of the #4, “Won the War,” with rider Maria Remedio, against the #5, “Lake Creek,” ridden by Alex Cintron, for coming out and bumping his horse in the stretch run. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. There was no Inquiry by the Stewards, or claim of foul by the rider until after she had talked to the owner. #1, “Jarrod’s Commando,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Ghostbuster,” and #6, “Parseghian,” were vet scratches. #5, “Lake Creek,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 – 1a - 3.” Starters - 5

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:58 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:59 p.m. The main track has been downgraded to SLOPPY starting with this race. #3, “Stack the Storm,” and #4, “Ava Again,” were scratched by their trainers. #11, “Heaven Help Me,” #12, “Wild Green Wave Girl,” and #13, “Kingdom’s Crown,” were scratched as alternates. #8, “Right or Wrong,” and #14, “E C’s Favorite,” were scratched due to this race being taken off the turf.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 9 - 5.” Starters - 7

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:25 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:25 p.m. Maria Remedio scheduled to ride #3, “Harlington Night,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. #1, “Prince Curlin,” #2, Sortano,” and #8, “Winding Road,” were vet scratches. #7, “Golden Rings,” was scratched by the Stewards upon the recommendation of management. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:53 p.m. Michael Ritvo scheduled to ride #6, “Seventyseven Ilene,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. #5, “Final Betrayal,” was scratched by its trainer for track conditions.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 6

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:21 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:24 p.m. #4, “Tammy’s Tailor,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Oella,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #6, “Cat’s Shadow,” got loose in the paddock running onto the main track before being caught by the outriders. The #6 was returned to the paddock and checked by Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner who reported that the horse was ok to run.
