Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Truesdail Laboratories Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #14911, taken from the horse “Mizz Martha” which ran in the 1st race on Saturday, June 13, 2015, contained “Fluphenazine,” The trainer of record, M.C. Reardon, was informed of the laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector’s Swift and Delaney conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Reardon’s assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed no prohibited items. Ms. Rearden waived her rights to a split sample. A hearing will be scheduled concerning this matter.
- Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. reported on their certificate of analysis for post-race test sample #14941, taken from the horse “Polar Sunrise” which ran in the 1st race on Monday, June 15, 2015, contained “Clenbuterol,” in the amount of 710 picograms per milliliter of plasma. The trainer of record, Herbert Miller, was informed of the laboratory finding by the Stewards. DTRC Inspector’s Swift and Delaney conducted a barn inspection of Trainer Miller’s assigned area. Results of the inspection revealed no prohibited items. Mr. Miller waived his rights to a split sample. A hearing will be scheduled concerning this matter.

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:51 p.m. Darius Thorpe scheduled to ride #2, “Jigsaw,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. #8, “Quarterback Sneak,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #4, “Dreaming of Andy A,” was claimed by John Rigattieri and T and C Stable LLC – John Rigattieri. #7, “Normal Practice,” was claimed by Nick Sanna Stables LLC – Michael Pino. #2, “Jigsaw,” returned lame from the race. The #2 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner who said the horse was off in the right front. The horse was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. #8, “Quarterback Sneak,” was placed on the Stewards list following his poor performance in this race and being eased for the second race in a row.
