FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #5, “Virginia Rose,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Edyanne,” was selected for a blood gas test. #6, “Edyanne,” was selected for a special post-race test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m. The main track has been downgraded to sloppy, starting with this race. **INQUIRY – AT THE EIGHTH POLE.** After reviewing the films of the race and talking to the rider of the #8, the Stewards disqualified the #8, “Reverend Green,” with rider Brian Pedroza from first and placed him last, for coming in at the eighth pole in the stretch run, causing the #7, “Goldland,” with rider Andry Blanco to clip heels and fall. The Stewards called first aid talking with the rider Mr. Blanco, who said he was ok. Mr. Blanco signed a medical release form at first aid, returning to the jockey’s quarters. Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown called the Stewards stating that the horse appeared to be ok. #5, “Sunrise Bird,” was selected for a blood gas test.

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:19 p.m. #6, “Taran Taran,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter.
