Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

A hearing was held for exercise rider Mr. William Terry, for allegedly injuring a horse with the tines of a pitchfork. There was no eye witness evidence presented at the hearing linking Mr. Terry to this incident. Charles Bell, the trainer of “Ala Firm” testified that Mr. Terry has worked for him for quite some time and did not believe that Mr. Terry was responsible for the injury to the horse. Due to the lack of evidence, there was no finding against Mr. Terry.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. INQUIRY AT THE HALF MILE POLE – The #2, “U So Wild,” ridden by Scott Spieth, broke down at the half mile pole. The injured horse was examined by Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown. Following examination by Dr. Brown, he determined that the horse suffered multiple fractures to its left front leg. Due to the catastrophic nature of the injury, the horse had to be humanely destroyed. Jockey Scott Spieth, who had pulled the injured horse up before dismounting, was not injured.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #2, “Normal Practice,” and #5, “D K Edge,” were vet scratches. #7, “My Man Dan,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #5, “Goodnight Angel,” and #6, “Over the Cliff,” were vet scratches. #2, “Melody Pomeroy,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

FOURTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m.
This race was scheduled at seven and one half furlongs on the turf, but ran at one mile on the main track. Gary Cruise scheduled to ride #3, “Nickos Red Star,” was changed to Tyler Conner; no double jocks mount. Daniel Centeno scheduled to ride #6, “Quiet Conquest,” was changed to Maria Remedio; no double jocks mount. #1, “I Ain’t Waitin,” #4, “King Gatto,” #7, “Alwaaly,” and #10,” Fasque,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #8, “Hauler,” was a vet scratch. #13, Pasta Giovanni,” and #14, “Cosmic Prince,” were scratched as alternates. #9, “Spirit in the Nite,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
ORDER OF FINISH – “12 - 5 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 7

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:15 p.m. #3, “Wildly Beautiful,” and #8, “Noon Shadow,” were vet scratches.
ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 6

SIXTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:45 p.m. #2, “Comedia,” #3, “Sassy Little Cat,” #6, “A Little Bit Sassy,” and #7, “Marabea (GB),” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. We canceled Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta, Place and Show wagering for this race as we were below four betting interests.
ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 4.” Starters - 3

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:16 p.m. Hold and claim of foul by the #3, “J C’s Diamond,” with rider Alcibiades Cortez against the #1, “Royal Marine,” with rider Alex Cintron, for coming in bumping him on the turn near the quarter pole. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. It was noted that no Inquiry was called by the Stewards in this race. Yomar Orlando Ortiz scheduled to ride #3, “J C’s Diamond,” was changed to Alcibiades Cortez; no double jocks mount. #7, “Alex’s Way,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Mid Ocean,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 1 - 6 - 5.” Starters - 7

EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m. #5, “Uptown Dannys Boy,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
