Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Associate Commission Veterinarian Kathleen Picciano is performing mandatory Graded Stakes testing for the “KENT STAKES Grade III.” and the “DELAWARE HANDICAP Grade I.”

Equine Forensic Drug Testing:

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All samples collected on July 7, 2015 were clear.
- All samples collected on July 8, 2015 were clear with the exception of samples #14501 and #14536 which were placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. . Kaylia Albright scheduled to ride #3, “Battleship Gray,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. #2, “Noble Abode,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Kholberg,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN.** Hold and claim of foul by the trainer Anthony Pecoraro and jockey Andry Blanco of the #6, “Kholberg,” against the #4, “Squared Away,” ridden by Carol Cedenno for coming out in the stretch run forcing his horse out. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race the Stewards disqualified the #4 from first to second, moving the #6 up to first for interference in the stretch. There was also a claim of foul at the top of the stretch by the trainer of the #5, “Strike It Now,” Dennis Griffith, against the #7, “Laster,” ridden by Erik Barbaran. Following an interview with the riders and reviewing the films of the race, we saw no reason to take any action against the #7 and made the race official. It was noted that jockey Mario Rodriguez the rider of the #5 did not file a claim of foul against the #7

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - THE KENT STAKES Grade III - POST TIME – 4:20 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:25 p.m. Joel Rosario scheduled to ride #2, “Chief Kitten,” was changed to Jon Kenton Court; as Mr. Rosario could not get within the mandatory overweight limit of five pounds. Mr. Rosario’s horse was in with the weight of 116 lbs. and lightest weight he could accomplish with his tack was 122.2 lbs. Abel Castellano Jr. scheduled to ride #3, “Money Multiplier,” was changed to Joe Bravo; no double jocks mount. #7, “Weekend Express,” was scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. All horses were selected for pre-race blood gas testing.

EIGHTH RACE – THE HOCKESSIN STAKES - POST TIME – 4:55 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:56 p.m. Kerwin Clark scheduled to ride #1, “Heaven’s Runway,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; double jocks mount will be charged. #2, “Service for Ten,” #4, “Let’s Get Crackin,” #7, “Stallwalkin Dude,” and #8, “Last Heartbreaker,” were scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #1, “Heaven’s Runway,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

NINTH RACE – ON THE TURF –POST TIME – 5:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:27 p.m.
#11, “Big Johnny D (IRE),” was a vet scratch. #6, “Harlington Night,” was scratched as a main-track only. #8, “Arion Silver,” and #13, “Balino,” were scratched by their trainers. #14, “Pasta Lover,” was scratched as an alternate. #10, “Almoradi (IRE),” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #12, “Back Away.” was scratched by the Stewards, after getting loose during the post parade and ran off for one-half mile before being apprehended by the outriders.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 7 - 5.” Starters - 8

TENTH RACE – THE DELAWARE HANDICAP Grade I - POST TIME – 5:59 p.m. OFF TIME – 6:03 p.m. All horses were selected for a pre-race blood gas testing. We received a phone call from Mr. John Wayne shortly after this race, stating that Mr. John Mooney was upset that the 2nd and 3rd place finishers were not informed that their horses were to be taken to the test barn to be tested. The winners circle caretaker Warren Harmon was informed by the clerk of scales to send the first three finishers. Mr. Harmon said that he knew about sending the first three finishers to the test barn, but the 2nd place horse had gotten away before he could let the groom know and give him the tag to be tested. The horse was re-routed to the test barn and was tested. We informed Mr. Harmon that if this happened in the future to let us know and we would send an outrider to inform the groom of the horse to be tested. *(DTRC Inspectors on the scene were made aware of the situation and confirmed that all three horses made their way to the test barn for sample collections without difficulty).*

We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.
