Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

**Administrative Hearings:**

We held racing film reviews today regarding the 1<sup>st</sup> race on Saturday, July 18, 2015. The riders involved in the incident for the review were Carol Cedenno and Andry Blanco. After reviewing the films with the riders involved, the Stewards rendered a decision that jockey Carol Cedenno be held blameless.

We also reviewed the racing films for the 1<sup>st</sup> race on Monday, July 20, 2015 involving an incident with jockeys Ricardo Chiappe and Daniel Centeno. Following the film review, the Stewards issued a 7 day suspension to Mr. Chiappe for careless riding.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #5, “Restricted List,”**  
was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 6**

**SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m.**  
Patrick Henry Jr. scheduled to ride #8, “Tampa Bay Blue,” was changed to Maria Remedio;  
no double jocks mount. Andry Blanco scheduled to ride #10, “Yo Berbs,” was changed to  
Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. #5, “Impressive Roberto,” was scratched as a  
main-track only. #6, “Arangol,” was selected for a Stewards special post-race test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 8 - 9.” Starters - 10**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. #4, “Cat McGinley,”**  
was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m.** Trevor McCarthy was named on two horses to ride; #7, “Stylish Step,” was changed to Matthew Rispoli; no double jocks mount and #13, “Variety of Colors,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. #1, “For Finery,” and #10, “Sweet Chant,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #9, “Then and Now,” was a vet scratch. #12, “Bwana, Barbie,” stumbled at the start.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 5 - 2.” Starters - 11**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m.** #3, “Currency Union,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #2b, “African Jewel,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Black Queen,” was a vet scratch. During the race there was a **Hold and Claim of Foul** by jockey Janelle Campbell rider of #2, “Lethal Lil Lady,” against the #1, “Purple Paisley,” with rider Daniel Feliciano, for coming in causing her to check her mount in mid- stretch. After interviewing to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. No Inquiry was called by the Stewards in this race. #7, “Summer Cocktail,” was claimed by Mark J. Ashby – Lynn Ashby. #8, “Tahaddi,” hopped out of the gate at the start

**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 8 - 1.” Starters - 9**

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:51 p.m.** #4, “Costa Dolce,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. Trevor McCarthy scheduled to ride #7, “Inside the Pipe,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. #5, “Easy Ten,” was scratched as a main-track only. #8, “Thirteenth Avenue,” was scratched by its trainer. During the race there was a **Hold and Claim of Foul** by jockey Ricardo Chiappe aboard #2, “Undeniable Temper,” against Mario Rodriguez who rode #11, “Happy Landing,” for coming in causing him to check his mount in mid-stretch at the turf course chute. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. No Inquiry was called by the Stewards in this race. #3, “Alpha Red,” was pulled up after the race at the seven furlong marker by Forest Boyce who dismounted and held the horse until the outrider arrived. “Alpha Red” was examined by Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who reported the horse pulled its suspensory in the right front. Subsequently, the horse was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. #7, “Inside the Pipe,” was claimed by Ocala West Won LLC – Anthony Russo.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 11 - 9.” Starters - 9**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:22 p.m.** Trevor McCarthy scheduled to ride #8, “Tori’s Guy,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. Carlos Luis Gutierrez scheduled to ride #5, “Imperial Force,” was changed to Leroy Nelson; no double jocks mount. #1, “Keep it Pithy,” was selected for a Stewards special post-race test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 8**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:58 p.m.** #1, “Half the Sky,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #4, “Kelly Drive,” was a vet scratch. The #8, “Tame,” was a late scratch by the Stewards as the horse flipped in the starting gate getting hung up and injured. The #8 was examined by Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, who recommended to the Stewards that the horse be scratched. During the race there was a **Hold and Claim of Foul** by the #3, “Savannah Mist,” ridden by Victor Carrasco against the #1a, “Stacey’s Pumpkin,” with rider David Amiss, for coming in brushing with his horse several times down the stretch. After interviewing the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. No Inquiry was called by the Stewards in this race. #2b, “Truth Only,” stumbled at the start.
