Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

**Equine Forensic Drug Testing:**

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Samples #14524 #14613 and #14776 collected on July 4, 2015 that were placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, were cleared.
- Sample #14776, collected on Jul 6, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was cleared.
- Samples collected on July 11, 2015 were clear with the exception of #14639 which was placed on hold to await a certificate of analysis.
- All samples collected on July 13, 2015 were clear.
- All Graded Stakes out of competition samples from July, 11, and July 18, 2015 were clear.

**FIRST RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:18 p.m.** #6, “Huaquechula,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Flatter’s Secret,” was scratched as a main-track only. #8, “Village Princess,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 8 - 4 - 3.” Starters - 6**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m.** #5, “Dream Ketch,” was a vet scratch. #6, “Frosty Pop Larry,” was scratched by the Stewards due to its foal certificate was not on file with the racing office. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

**THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m.**

During the Race there was a **Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Andrew Wolfsont aboard #4, “Lil’ Zilla,” against Carol Cedenno who rode #7, “Shaikha,” for coming out causing him to stop riding his horse down the stretch. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. . No Inquiry was called by the Stewards in this race. #9, “The Best Love,” was scratched as a main-track only. #5, “Lana Lang,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #1, “Three Timer,” was selected for a Stewards special post-race test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 8**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:56 p.m.** #1, “Famous Jameis,” was a vet scratch. The #2, “Small and Fast,” flipped in the starting gate and injured itself according to Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner. Due to the injury the horse was scratched by the Stewards. Jockey, Martin Solis, the rider of the #2 along with Assistant Starter, Carlos Diaz were transported to First Aid for evaluation. Mr. Solis was taken off his remaining mounts for the day upon the recommendation of EMT Christine Demchak. Mr. Diaz was transported to the hospital for further evaluation. Due to the incidents caused by the #2 and the injuries sustained, there was a seven minute delay in the start of this race to await the return of the transport ambulance. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 5**

**FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:30 p.m.**

Trevor McCarthy scheduled to ride #2, “Smarty Star,” was changed to Joe Bravo; no double jocks mount. Alex Cintron scheduled to ride #5, “Proudly We Hail,” was changed to Forest Boyce; no double jocks mount. #1, “Smarty Star,” was a vet scratch. #8, “Vale Ridge,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #7, “I’m Really Sumthin,” broke through the gate prior to the start and ran one mile before being apprehended by the outriders. The #7 was subsequently scratched. Its rider, Daniel Centeno was taken to First Aid for evaluation. EMT, Mandy Tjadem reported to the Stewards that Jockey Centeno was cleared to ride his remaining mounts.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 7**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:00 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:01 p.m.** Martin Solis, scheduled to ride . #7, “Paytoplay,” was changed to Pierre Tomas; no double jocks mount. #7, “Paytoplay,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 4 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 7**

**SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:29 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:34 p.m.**

Trevor McCarthy scheduled to ride #7, “Heavenly Summer,” was changed to Tyler Conner; no double jocks mount.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 10 - 5.” Starters - 10**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:02 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:04 p.m.** John W. Lloyd, scheduled to ride #8, “Aragonesa,” was changed to Maria Remedio; no double jocks mount. #2, “My African Nurses,” was scratched by its trainer.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 7**

**NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:30 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:32 p.m.** Scott Spieth scheduled to ride #6, “Front Row,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. #4, “RB Big N Rich,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Tella Machine,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #1, “RB Royale Madame,” got loose during the post parade and ran five-eighths of a mile before being caught by the outriders. This horse was subsequently scratched.
