Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

We called trainer Jake Secor in on Tuesday May 19, 2014, for allegedly not wearing a safety vest while astride a horse on the grounds of Delaware Park. During interview, Mr. Secor related that he does wear a vest, but has his shirt over the top of the vest, making it hard to tell if he has one on. No further action was warranted.

On Tuesday, May 19, 2015 an assistant trainers test was issued to Groom Ms. Heidi K. Wehner. Ms. Wehner has successfully completed the assistant trainers test, and was issued a certificate for her accomplishment.

We held movies today for the sixth race, from Monday, May 18, 2015. The riders involved in the incident for the movies were Brian Pedroza and Andry Blanco. After reviewing the films with the riders involved, the Stewards rendered a decision of a 10 day suspension for jockey Brian Pedroza, for extremely carless riding.

fifteen minutes to post. The #2 had gotten loose going into the paddock, and then running off one mile on the main track before being caught by the outriders.
