Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

### **Administrative Hearings:**

Today we tested an Exercise Rider who tested positive for marijuana. The subject waived his right to a formal hearing and was suspended pending evaluation and recommendation from the horsemen's Drug and Alcohol counselor. The counselor Ms. Nan Bernardo M.S.C.C. must send the Stewards a written evaluation and recommendation, before a reinstatement hearing will be conducted.

We also tested a Hot Walker who tested positive for marijuana. The subject waived his right to a formal hearing and was suspended pending evaluation and recommendation from the horsemen's Drug and Alcohol counselor. The Stewards must receive a written evaluation and recommendation, before a reinstatement hearing will be conducted.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m.** Jevian Toledo scheduled to ride #5, "Nuestra Senor," was changed to Julian Pimentel; no double jocks mount. #4, "Dragon Attack," was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – "7 - 9 - 4 - 8." Starters - 9**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m.** Wallynette Rodriguez, scheduled to ride #8, "Stormin Margaret," was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. #2, "Zimbabwe Lady," #3, "Humerous Delite," and #9, "Frisbee," were vet scratches. #7, "Flo's Strawberry," was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. After a two-way shake, #6, "Risky Or Not," was claimed by Triple R Stable – Rodolfo Romero. #5, "Proulette," fell just past the finish line, unseating its rider, Jomar Ortega. The #5 was examined by Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who reported that the horse looked uninjured. The horse walked off the racing surface under its own power. Jockey Jomar Ortega was transported to first aid for evaluation. First aid was contacted with EMT Mike Cooper reporting that Mr. Ortega was cleared, signed a refusal of treatment form and returned to the jockey's quarters.

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m.** Jevian Toledo, scheduled to ride #2, “Charlie Bull,” was changed to Victor Carrasco; no double jocks mount. #7, “Normal Practice,” was a vet scratch. #4, “War Hitch,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 6 - 9 - 3.” Starters - 8**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m.** #13, “Petite Warrior,” and #14, “Summertime Thunder,” were scratched as alternates.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 8 - 6 - 9.” Starters - 12**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:29 p.m.** #3, “Cool Bu Moon,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #1, “Quay to Heaven,” was selected for a Stewards special post-race test. #10, “Frostys Whirl,” was scratched by the stewards after a seven-minute delay, as the horse would not load into the starting gate. The #4, “Noon Shadow,” bobbled shortly after the start. We called the rider of the #4 David Amis asking him what had caused the horse to bobble. Mr. Amis stated that the horse had grabbed a quarter, tearing off part of its left front heel.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 8 - 3 - 9.” Starters - 8**

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:58 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:02 p.m.** #6, “Bonnet Plume,” was scratched as a main-track only.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 4 - 1 - 9.” Starters - 8**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:31 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:32 p.m.** #4, “Sixty Milesperhour,” pulled up down the backstretch, with rider Abel Castellano Jr. dismounting and holding the horse until the outrider arrived. The #4 was examined by Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, who reported the horse looked sound, with the horse walking off the racing surface under its own power. We spoke with rider Abel Castellano Jr. who advised that the horse was not travelling well, so he pulled him up.

**EIGHTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 4:59 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:00 p.m.** #1, “RB Rich Kin,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.  
**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 4 - 5 - 3.” Starters - 6**
