Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets, and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

We had scheduled a hearing this morning at 10:00 a.m. for Pari-Mutuel Employee Jonathan Miller. Mr. Miller failed to show for his scheduled hearing and will be suspended indefinitely pending his appearance before the board of Stewards.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Graded Stakes samples collected on July 18, 2015 were cleared.
- Remaining samples collected on July 18, 2015 were clear with the exception of #14329, #14684, #15262 and #15293 which were placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Samples collected on July 20, 2015 were clear with the exception of #14345 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:15 p.m.
ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m. #1a, “Great Aztec,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. During the race: **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Augusto Marin rider of the #6, “Heza Fox,” against the #7, “Catch Me Kaz,” ridden by Tyler Conner. The claim of foul was in reference to the #7, “Catch Me Kaz” coming over in front of the #6, during the stretch run and forcing jockey Marin to take up and steady his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #7, “Catch Me Kaz,” for interference in the stretch and placed him third, moving the #6, “Heza Fox,” to second .

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:20 p.m. #3, “Furthur,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #6, “Space Trip,” stumbled at the start.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:50 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:53 p.m. Carlos Gutierrez, scheduled to ride #13, “Armi Base,” was changed to Christian Dominguez; no double jocks mount. #3, “Aragvi,” was scratched by its trainer for heat related issues. #11, “Wonderful Union,” was scratched as a main-track only. #14, “Is Not,” was scratched as an alternate. **INQUIRY AT THE SEVEN EIGHTHS POLE -** #8, “Manzutti,” broke down in the first turn at the seven furlong marker, unseating its rider, Vince Halliday. The #8 was examined by Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who reported the horse had possibly broken its right shoulder. The horse was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. Jockey Vince Halliday was transported to first aid for evaluation. First aid was contacted and EMT Chris Demczak reported that Mr. Halliday was cleared to resume riding, had signed a refusal of treatment form and returned to the jockey’s quarters. #12, “Precious Metal,” stumbled at the start.

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:25 p.m. Roimes Chirinos, scheduled to ride #2, “Epic Story,” was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #4, “Captain Munnings,” was scratched by its trainer for heat related issues.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 6 - 7.” Starters - 6

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:54 p.m. #4, “Pebble Beach Baby,” was scratched as a main-track only. #9, “Acquant,” was scratched by its trainer due to heat related issues. #5, “Vielsalm,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. **Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Trevor McCarthy of the #2, “Attainment,” against the #1, “Marabea (GB),” ridden by Joe Bravo. The claim of foul was in reference to the #1, “Marabea (GB)” coming out in front of #2, “Attainment” during the deep stretch run and forcing jockey McCarthy to stop riding his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, it was the Stewards opinion that the #1 was clear when coming out after going by the #2 in deep stretch. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. No Inquiry was called by the Stewards in this race.

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:23 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:24 p.m. Matthew Rispoli, scheduled to ride #3, “Pride of Stride,” was changed to Joshua Navarro; no double jocks mount. #5, “Unzapped,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 8 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 9

EIGHTH RACE – THE WHITE CLAY CREEK STAKES - POST TIME – 4:52 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:54 p.m. #8, “Sally’s News,” was scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #6, “Bella Flor,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 3 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 8
