Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative:

Associate Commission Veterinarian Kathleen Picciano is substituting for Dr. Richard Brown.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- All Out of Competition samples collected for July 2015 were clear.
- Samples #14329, #14684, #15262, and #15293, collected on July 20, 2015 which had been placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, were cleared.
- Sample #14345 collected on July 20, 2015 which had been placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was cleared.
- Samples collected on July 21, 2015 were cleared.
- Samples collected on July 22, 2015 were clear with the exception of #14462 which returned positive for “Dimethyl Sulfoxide” (DMSO). The trainer of this horse, Mr. McLean Robertson was contacted and issued a warning for this class five violation.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:15 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. Hold and claim of foul by jockey Ricardo Chiappe of the #2, “Fly Private,” against the #5, “Discreet Reason,” ridden by Scott Spieth. The claim of foul was in reference to the #5, “Discreet Reason” coming over in front of #2, “Fly Private” during the stretch run and forcing jockey Chiappe to take his horse up sharply. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #5, “Discreet Reason,” from first and placed him fifth behind #2, “Fly Private,” who was moved to fourth from fifth. Also of note, the #2, “Fly Private,” broke down at the eighth-pole in the stretch. The #2 was examined by Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who reported that the horse had possibly broken its right front knee. The horse was removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance. #6, “Royal L. S.,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:50 p.m. Luis Garcia, scheduled to ride #5, “School House,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. #4, “Concealed Identity,” was scratched as a main-track only. #2, “Crime Time,” and #7, “Big Johnny D (IRE),” were vet scratches.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 1 - 3 - 9.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:20 p.m. #2, “Passion Trail,” was a vet scratch. #6, “My Missus,” was scratched by the Stewards upon recommendation from Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who advised that the horse had flipped in the paddock injuring itself. #3, “Flying Slew,” was claimed by Triple R Stable – Rodolfo Romero. #7, “Spanish Dream,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:52 p.m. Roimes Chirinos, scheduled to ride #9, “Under the Bridge,” was changed to Eric Camacho; no double jocks mount. #10, “Creature of Luxe,” was scratched as a main-track only. #2, “Stormy Salute,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
