Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

The Stewards have rendered a decision in the case of Ms. M. C. Reardon concerning the “Fluphenazine,” positive, for the horse “Mizz Martha,” who won the first race on Saturday, June 13, 2015. Ms. Reardon was issued a fifteen-day suspension and a \$500.00 fine. The horse, “Mizz Martha” will be disqualified from all purse monies, from the first race on Saturday, June 13, 2015. The Stewards based their decision on testimony and evidence presented at the administrative hearing that the horse was treated by Ms. Reardon’s veterinarian 37 days prior to racing for being nervous after shipping to Delaware Park. The veterinarian recommended to Ms. Reardon a thirty-day withdrawal time for this medication. Ms. Reardon had waited thirty-seven days to run the horse. Ms. Reardon had no prior violations of any type. We found no malicious intent by the trainer or veterinarian in this case. Ms. Reardon has indicated that she may appeal the Stewards decision to the Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission and was furnished appeal forms.

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. #5, “Minor Crisis,” was scratched as a main-track only.

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:20 p.m. #1, “Talinsky,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:53 p.m. #3, “Crimson Valor,” was scratched as a main-track only. #10, “Riplz,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:23 p.m. #5, “Keep It Pithy,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 5 - 6 - 3.” Starters - 8

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:53 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:56 p.m. William Otero, scheduled to ride #3, “Turks and Chaos,” was changed to Maria Remedio; no double jocks mount. #9, “Smuggling,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 8 - 9.” Starters - 9

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:26 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:28 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE FIRST TURN AND DEEP STRETCH – Going into the first turn #3, “Ransom Paid,” was in tight quarters with jockey Trevor McCarthy having to check his mount. **Hold and claim of foul in deep stretch**, by #10, “Sweet Visionary,” with rider Ricardo Chiappe, against the #7, “Concerto’s Encore,” and rider Keiber Coa for coming out in front of him in deep stretch. After reviewing the films and talking to the riders involved, the Stewards determined that the #7 was clear of the #10 when coming out. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. #8, “Lataam,” was a vet scratch. #11, “Conman,” was scratched as an alternate.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 2 - 10 - 4.” Starters - 9

EIGHTH RACE – THE STRIKE YOUR COLORS STAKES - POST TIME – 5:00 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:01 p.m. #2, “Fashion Designer,” was scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. **INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Victor Carrasco of the #1, “Patrick Rocks,” against the #3, “Morning Fire,” ridden by Frankie Pennington. The claim of foul was in reference to the #3, “Morning Fire” coming out in front of #1, “Patrick Rocks,” during the stretch run and forcing jockey Carrasco to take his horse up sharply, causing the #6, “Sweet Steppin,” with rider Xavier Perez to clip heels and fall, and the #7, “Orbital Flight,” with rider Carol Cedeno unable to avoid the fallen horse also going down. After talking to the riders involved and viewing the films of the race, we disqualified the #3, “Morning Fire,” from second and placed him last, moving the #1, “Patrick Rocks,” up to third from fourth. We contacted EMT Mandy Pjaden at first aid who informed us that, Mr. Perez and Ms. Cedeno were both uninjured and signed a waiver form and returned to the jockeys’ quarters.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 8 - 1 - 5.” Starters - 7

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:34 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:35 p.m. #3 Qweens Lace,” was scratched by the Stewards, as jockey Carol Cedeno was unseated in the eight race and was unable to ride. #6, “R B Royale Madame,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 5 - 4.” Starters - 5
