Associate Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts is substituting for Dr. John Peters today.

Jockey Mr. Brian Pedroza came in this morning, to appeal the 10 day suspension issued by the Stewards for extremely careless riding. The extremely careless riding, occurred in the sixth race on Monday, May 18, 2015. The horse "Reverend Green," was disqualified from first and placed last.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Hold and claim of foul by the #4, "Blushing Romeo," with rider Michael Ritvo, against the #5, "Pro Prospect," with rider Felix Reyes. Jockey Ritvo told the Stewards that the #5 had come in shortly after the start causing him to have to check his mount. After talking to both riders involved, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. No Inquiry was called into the running of this race.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Eric Vera Rodriguez, the scheduled rider on the #1, "The Five Points," was changed to Larry Mejias; no double jocks mount. #3, "Hammer Song," was a vet scratch. #4, "Barbada," stumbled at the start.

ORDER OF FINISH – "6 - 4 - 2 - 7." Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #7, "Hardwired," was selected for a blood gas test.

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:46 p.m. The #5 horse “E Lizzy,” was scratched by the Stewards. It was noted that the horse “E Lizzy,” was awarded first place through a disqualification from a race on May 4, 2015 by the Stewards at Parx Racing. Therefore the horse was ineligible for the race conditions. This had taken place, after the time of entry in Delaware.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 2 – 1a.” Starters - 7

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m. Two claims in for the #1, Gold Potion,” were void. The first claim by Juan Coronel was **VOID** as the claim slip was put in the claim box without an envelope. The second claim by Alejandro Reyes was **VOID** for lack of sufficient funds in the horsemen’s account. #3, “Miss Dayna Lee,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness. The owner and trainer that claimed the #3, “Miss Dayna Lee, “requested a \$140.00 all-inclusive special test.

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:48 p.m. Clinton Potts, the scheduled rider on the #2, “Titanium Jo,” was changed to Josean Ramirez; no double jocks mount. #1, “Toast of Mayfair,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Camille Claudel,” was selected for a blood gas test.

NINTH RACE – ARABIANS - POST TIME – 5:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:17 p.m. #4, “Sergeant Pepper MHF,” was selected for a blood gas test. #4, “Sergeant Pepper MHF,” stumbled at the start.
