Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

On Monday, August 17, 2015 we tested an Exercise Rider who tested positive for Cocaine. The subject waived her right to a formal hearing and was suspended pending evaluation and recommendation from the horsemen's Drug and Alcohol counselor. The counselor Ms. Nan Bernardo M.S.C.C. must send the Stewards a written evaluation and recommendation, before a reinstatement hearing will be considered.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:17 p.m. #1, "Passion Trail," and #8, "Bwana Barbie," were vet scratches. After a two-way shake, #7, "Cowtown Brown," was claimed by Maria Claire Vansant – Douglas Nunn. A claim in for the #7, "Cowtown Brown," by Trainer Guy Smith was VOID as Mr. Smith had not started a horse in his name as Owner.

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. Javier Felix Jr. scheduled to ride #7, "Miss Modela," was changed to Vincente Gudiel; no double jocks mount. #9, "Forever Lily," #10, "Smarty Maddy," #11, "Hurricane Bluff Dr," #12, "Catching Up," #13, "Dandy Ketch," and #14, "Lelamaux," were scratched as alternates. **Hold and claim of foul** by Jockey, Vincente Gudiel of the #7, "Miss Modela," against the #4, "Silver Truffle," ridden by Ricardo Chiappe. The claim of foul was in reference to the #4, "Silver Truffle," coming out in front of #7, "Miss Modela," during the stretch run and forcing Jockey Gudiel to steady his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official as the #7 came out during the stretch run, but was clear while doing so. No inquiry was called by the Stewards into the running of this race. #1, "Jessica's Ride," was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 3 - 2.” Starters - 7

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:54 p.m.

Gerald Almodovar scheduled to ride #1, “Minor Crisis,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. Tyler Conner, named on #3, “Kholberg,” was changed to Mario Rodriguez; no double jocks mount. Forest Boyce, scheduled to ride #8, “Horse Harlan,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. #6, “Sweet Lew,” was a vet scratch. #10, “Seeking Harmony,” was scratched as an alternate. We had an 8 minute delay in the start of this race, as we had a late scratch. The #2, “Storm Summation,” was scratched by the Stewards upon the recommendation of Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner after the horse flipped in the gate hitting its back, and then sat down. #1, “Minor Crisis,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 5 - 7 - 9.” Starters - 7

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:25 p.m. #3, “Jerico Call,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Dr. Suer,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #5, “Onthewhistle,” was claimed by Madeline Huis – Ruben Monjes. #7, “Dr. Suer,” pulled up sore after the race at the seven furlong marker. The #7 was examined by Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, who reported the horse had strained a tendon. Consequently, the horse was removed from the racing surface via the horse ambulance.

#10, “Our Emerald Forest (IRE),” was scratched as an alternate.

named on #2, “Extrasexyhippzster,” was changed to Angel Castillo; no double jocks mount.

#4, “Castaway,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 1 - 5 - 7.” Starters - 7

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:29 p.m. Christian Navarro,

scheduled to ride #11, “Red Hot for Slew,” was changed to Kali Francois; no double jocks

mount. #3, “Talent Man,” was a vet scratch. #9, “Flyin Away,” was selected for a pre-race

blood gas test. #5, “Beau Fox,” unseated its rider, Ricardo Chiappe during the post parade.

The horse which was loose for a short period of time, was caught by the outriders and taken to the starting gate where it successfully competed in the race.
