Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Associate Commission Veterinarian Susan Botts is substituting for Dr. Richard Brown.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. INQUIRY IN THE STRETCH RUN. Hold and claim of foul by jockey Pierre Tomas of the #1, “American Goods,” against the #5, “Catular,” ridden by Christian Navarro. The claim of foul was in reference to the #5, “Catular,” coming out bumping and forcing out the #1, “American Goods,” during the stretch run. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #5, “Catular,” for bumping and carrying out the #1, “American Goods,” in the stretch run and placed him second, moving the #1, “American Goods,” up to first. #3, “Our Bernie,” and #4, “Roar of Rohan,” were vet scratches. #1, “American Goods,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta, and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

Acosta, scheduled to ride #9, “Dreamingoffirst,” was changed to Julian Pimentel; no double jocks mount. 5, “Double Prophecy,” was a vet scratch. #10, “Hail to Rocknroll,” #11, “Unspoken,” and #12, “Honorable Break,” were scratched as alternates. #4, “Lana Lang,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
