Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

All three Stewards attended a Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission this morning at 10:15 a.m.

**Administrative Hearing:**

The Stewards held movies today concerning apprentice jockey Christian Navarro, whose horse “Catular” was disqualified for interference during the stretch run in the first race on August 18, 2015. As a result of the hearing Mr. Navarro will be suspended for seven calendar days from Thursday, August 20, through and including Wednesday, August 26, 2015 for careless riding.

**Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:**

- Samples collected on August 8, and 10, 2015 were cleared.
- Workout sample 14628 collected on August 12, 2015 was cleared.

**FIRST RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m.**  
**INQUIRY AT THE START** – The #5, “Pasta Giovanni,” hit the side of the gate at the start, causing the jockey, Miguel Osorio to lose his stirrup. About half way through the race Jockey Osorio regained his stirrup. #9, “Mr. Canada,” and #10, “Sidebysidedelcoco,” were scratched as alternates. #6, “Awesome Group,” was selected for a blood gas test. **ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 8**

**SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. Following the first race, the Main Track was downgraded to sloppy and the remaining turf races were taken off due to heavy rains.** #2, “Debutant Girl,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Holiday Wishes,” was scratched by its trainer.

**THIRD RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m.** J. D. Acosta, scheduled to ride #8, “Neidermeyer,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. #9, “Crime Time,” #10, “Grad Student,” and #11, “Mia Poppy,” were scratched as alternates. #6, “Back Away,” was scratched as this race was taken off the turf.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 8 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 7**

**FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. Hold and claim of foul** by the trainer of the #4, “Gitanilla,” Rodolfo Romero with rider Mario Rodriguez, against the #2, “Cause for Victory,” with rider Scott Spieth for coming in bumping his horse in the stretch run. After talking to rider Mario Rodriguez, of the #4, “Gitanilla,” who did not claim foul, he stated that his horse was at fault, not the #2 horse. After reviewing the films the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. #7, “Tahaddi,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 4 - 1 - 5.” Starters – 7**

**FIFTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:19 p.m.** #1a, “Village Reward,” was scratched as part of a same owner-entry. #3, “Steelaway Lady,” was scratched by its trainer. #4, “Tarkia,” and #9, “Extol,” were scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #10, “Petite Warrior,” was scratched as an alternate. **Hold and claim of foul** by Jockey, Trevor McCarthy rider of #5, “Stylish Step,” against the #1, “Smarty Maddy,” ridden by Ricardo Chiappe. The claim of foul was in reference to the #1, “Smarty Maddy,” bumping with him at the three-eighths pole and coming out in front of him at the top of the stretch. Following interview of both riders involved and film reviews, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official, as the #1 never appeared to make contact with the #5 at the three-eighths pole, with the #5 coming out at the top of the stretch, and the #1 staying in his path around the turn. No inquiry was called by the Stewards, into the running of this race.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “1 - 5 - 7 - 6.” Starters - 6**

**SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m.** Gabriel Saez, named on #7, “Make Big Money,” was changed to Janelle Campbell; no double jocks mount #1, “Unforgivable Fire,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Zoetic,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 6 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 6**

**SEVENTH RACE – OFF THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m.** Andry Blanco scheduled to ride #6, “Vakeesh,” was changed to Tyler Conner; no double jocks mount. #7, “Scoria,” was scratched as this race was taken off the turf. #6, “Vakeesh,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “5 – 6 - 2 - 4.” Starters - 7**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:47 p.m.** Erik Barbaron, scheduled to ride #1, “The Narrows,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. Tyler Conner scheduled to ride #8, “Sterling Thunder,” was changed to Kali Francois; no double jocks mount. #6, David’s Prince,” was a vet scratch. #1, “The Narrows,” was selected for a blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “11 - 8 - 2 - 9.” Starters - 10**

**NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:17 p.m.** Amelia Green, scheduled to ride #7, “A. P. Holiday,” was changed to Nik Juarez; no double jocks mount. #9, “Fictitious,” was a vet scratch. #2, “Distorted Emotion,” had a change of equipment to “Blinkers On” that was omitted from the changes in the program. Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner recommended to the Stewards that the #3, “Assist,” be scratched, as the horse was not warming up well during the post parade.
