Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Leroy Nelson, named on #2, “Harley’s Joy,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. J.D. Acosta, scheduled to ride #3, “Bringhomethecrown,” was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 3 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #4, “Horatio,” and #9, “Dixie Notion,” were vet scratches. #2, “Inflation Target,” #7, “Corporate Measure,” and #10, “Avanzando,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter.

ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 5 - 1 - 11.” Starters - 6

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m. Keiber Coa, scheduled to ride #4, “No Brag All Fact,” was changed to Miguel Osorio; no double jocks mount. #3, “Tappinintovictory,” was scratched as a main-track only. #6, “Proud Patriot,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #1a, “Hard Drive,” and 11, “Hunter,” were scratched as alternates.

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:47 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:48 p.m. Horacio Karamanos, the scheduled rider on #10, “Money Fan,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. #3, “Chuckie’s Honor,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #4, “Justforgetaboutit,” and #9, “Just Irish,” were vet scratches. #6, “Alluseeismytale,” was scratched by its trainer. #1, “Battled,” was claimed by Juan Arriagada – Anthony Pecoraro.

ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 1 - 7 - 2.” Starters - 7

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:20 p.m. #10, “Mustang Alley,” #11, “Sequiota,” #12, “Why Not Be Queen,” and #13, “C’Est Moi,” Andry Blanco, named on #2, “Sir Rockport,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. #14, “Gulf Coast Breeze,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #8, “Fearless Princess,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:50 p.m. #6, “In Da Clear,” was selected for a blood gas test. The #4, “Golden Steel,” broke slowly. Trevor McCarthy, jockey of the #6, “In Da Clear,” pulled up before returning to the unsaddling area and dismounted due to concerns with the way the horse was traveling. Commission Veterinarian, Jane Teichner examined “In Da Clear” and discovered it had lost its right front shoe. The horse was subsequently removed from the racing surface via horse ambulance.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 4 - 6.” Starters – 6.

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:22 p.m. #1a, “Domo Artiegato,” was scratched as an alternate. #7, “Surf’s Up,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 6 - 1 - 7.” Starters - 9

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:51 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:52 p.m. Andry Blanco, named on #2, “Sir Rockport,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. #6, “Etruscan,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #1, “Quake in My Wake,” stumbled shortly after the start.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 6 - 4 - 5.” Starters - 6

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:21 p.m. Trevor McCarthy; scheduled to ride #4, “Right On Course,” was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. **INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START - Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Scott Spieth of the #2, “Great Aztec,” against the #3, “Fond of Candy,” ridden by David Amiss. The claim of foul was in reference to the #3, “Fond of Candy,” coming over in front of #2, “Great Aztec,” shortly after the start forcing jockey Spieth to check his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards disqualified the #3, from second placing him third and moving the #2, up to second. #6, “Pro Prospect,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. . #4, “Right On Course,” was claimed by Juan Arriagada – Anthony Pecoraro.
