Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

Administrative Hearings:

We held a hearing this morning for veterinarian Dr. Amy Warren. The hearing was conducted for failure to list the treatment of the horse “Mizz Martha” on Thursday, May 7, 2015, on her daily treatment slips. Dr. Warren will be fined the sum of \$500.00 dollars for the violation of D.T.R.C. rules 15.4.3 and 15.4.4.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Victor Carrasco, scheduled to ride #6, “Twelve Stone,” was changed to Andre Worrie; no double jocks mount. #1, “Stevie’s Wonder,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #3, “Smiling Charlie,” was a vet scratch. #4, “Ima Wildcat,” was scratched by the racing office. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “1a - 5 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 4

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:49 p.m. Victor Carrasco, named on #8, “Christiansted,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. #9, “Tiz Madness,” #10, “Leroids Mommie,” #11, “Mrs Barbaroux,” #12, “Don’s Girl,” #13, “Kanaka,” and #14, “Fabulous Devotion,” were scratched as alternates. #5, “Miss Coco,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #4, “Initial Return,” trailed the field and was eased in the stretch by its rider, Gabriel Saez. Jockey Saez advised the Stewards that his horse was trying, but could not keep up with the field and thought best to ease her.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 5 - 8.” Starters - 8

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:19 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:27 p.m. The #5, “Little Pharoah,” was scratched by Associate Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, as the horse flipped in the gate and injured itself. We had a 7 minute delay in the start of this race due to the scratch of the #5. There was an **INQUIRY AT THE START** as the #1, “Email Me the Goods,” refused to break from the starting gate when the gates opened. This horse was added to the Starter’s List.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 7 - 3.” Starters – 7

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:55 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:58 p.m. #3, “Crimson Valor,” was scratched as a main-track only. #10, “Run Time,” #11, “Pedregal,” #12, “Revive and Resurge,” #13, “Flaming Humor,” and #14, “Pontius P.,” were scratched as alternates.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 7 - 5 - 8.” Starters - 8

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:27 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:28 p.m. Jorge A. Vargas Jr. scheduled to ride #2, “Westoniana,” was changed to Wilfredo Lozano Jr.; no double jocks mount. Victor Carrasco, named on #5, “Printasticat,” was changed to Andre Worrie; no double jocks mount. #7, Supsa,” was scratched as the horse was treated with medication by mistake. #3, “Star of the Forest,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 6 - 3 - 5.” Starters - 6

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:56 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:59 p.m. Victor Carrasco, scheduled to ride #11, “Dodging,” was changed to Tyler Conner; no double jocks mount. #4, “Forgotten Knot,” was scratched as a main-track only. #5, “Lucky Year,” was scratched by the racing office. #9, “Arc Above,” was a vet scratch. #12, “Nineinthenine,” and #13, “Ring it Up,” were scratched as alternates. #3, “Diana’s Vendetta,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #6, “Hobbs,” was claimed by Bruno Schickendanz – Aldana Gonzalez.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 3 - 11 - 10.” Starters - 8

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:29 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:31 p.m. Victor Carrasco scheduled to ride #9, “Keep It Pithy,” was changed to Alex Cintron; no double jocks mount. #1a, “If I Win Thelotto,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Holiday Boy,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Golden Rings,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #7, “Golden Rings,” was claimed by Helen Marshall – Kieron Magee. A claim in for the #7, “Golden Rings,” by Silvio Martin was **VOID** as the claim blank was not placed in a claim envelope.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 6 - 3 - 8.” Starters - 9

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:59 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:59 p.m. Victor Carrasco, named on #3, “Springmeier,” was changed to Carol Cedeno; no double jocks mount. **Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Trevor McCarthy of the #7, “Cowboy Prince,” against the #2, “Majestic Hussar,” ridden by Xavier Perez. The claim of foul was in reference to the #2, “Majestic Hussar,” coming out in front of #7, “Cowboy Prince,” during the stretch run allegedly causing jockey McCarthy to steady his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official as the #7 did come out during the stretch run, but was well clear when doing so. No inquiry was called by the Stewards, into the running of this race.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 7 - 1 - 8.” Starters - 8

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:30 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:31 p.m. Victor Carrasco, scheduled to ride #3, “Arangol,” was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #8, “Discreet Reason,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. The #4, “Easy Ten,” unseated its jockey, Carol Cedeno, as the horse stumbled when pulling up following the race. Jockey Cedeno was transported to hospital for evaluation.
