Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Ever Argueta, scheduled to ride #3, “Silk n’ Sequins,” was changed to Mario Rodriguez; double jocks mount will be charged. #1, “Clapping,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #1a, “Flo’s Strawberry,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 – 1a - 5.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:48 p.m. Clinton Potts, named on #7, “Fairbanks Gold,” was changed to Abel Castellano Jr.; no double jocks mount. #8, “Cool Roger,” was scratched as a main-track only.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 1 - 7 - 4.” Starters - 7

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:19 p.m. #1, “Stormy Goods,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. **Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Scott Spieth, rider of #9, “Crimson Valor,” against the #6, “Peppi the Hunter,” ridden by Keiber Coa. The claim of foul was in reference to the #6, “Peppi the Hunter,” coming in at the top of the stretch bumping with #9, “Crimson Valor,” causing jockey Spieth’s horse to allegedly lose stride. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. Our observation was that the #9 came out during the stretch run and the #6 came inward. No inquiry was called by the Stewards into the running of this race.

ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 9 - 8 - 2.” Starters – 9

FOURTH RACE – POST TIME – 2:48 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:54 p.m. Jose Lopez, scheduled to ride #2, “Lu Lu Belle,” was changed to Erik Barbaran; no double jocks mount. Andry Blanco, named on #4, “Laurie’s Vision,” was changed to Trevor McCarthy; no double jocks mount. We had a six minute delay in the start of this race, as the #3, “R Rousey,” unseated jockey Tyler Conner during the post parade. Consequently, “R Rousey,” was scratched by the Stewards as she ran off three-quarters of a mile before being caught in the quarter mile chute. Mr. Conner was uninjured and returned to the jockeys room. #6, “Shooting Doves,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 6 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 6

FIFTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:22 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:24 p.m.

Javier Felix Jr. scheduled to ride #6, “Lin Marie,” was changed to Brian Pedroza; no double jocks mount. #2, “Perched,” was a vet scratch. #5, “Sweet Henrietta,” was scratched as a main-track only. #8, “Lotta Irish,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #3, “Why Not Be Queen,” was claimed by Midwest Thoroughbreds Inc. – Jamie Ness.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 6

SIXTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:54 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:55 p.m. Ever Argueta, named on #1, “Scat Daddys Breeze,” was changed to Mario Rodriguez; double jocks mount will be charged. #3, “Dance Wild,” was a vet scratch. After a two-way shake, #1, “Scat Daddys Breeze,” was claimed by Home Team Stables – Scott Lake.

ORDER OF FINISH – “5 - 7 - 1 - 8.” Starters - 7

SEVENTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 4:24 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:27 p.m.

Anthony Salgado, scheduled to ride #4, “Golden Rivet,” was changed to Jevian Toledo; no double jocks mount. #5, Call First,” was scratched as the horse is on the vets list in New Jersey. #6, Bank Float,” and #8, “Fantasize,” were vet scratches. #2, “Troubled Waters,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 7 - 1.” Starters - 5

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:57 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:58 p.m. Maria Remedio, scheduled to ride #8, “What’s On His Toes,” was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount. #3, “Hobson B,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “8 - 3 - 1 - 9.” Starters - 10

NINTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:25 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:27 p.m. Daniel Centeno, named on #7, “Kooldealjonsteill,” was changed to Wilfredo Lozano Jr.; no double jocks mount. #5, “Mazur,” was a vet scratch. **OBJECTION POSTED ON TOTE BOARD – RESCINDED** - Outrider, Colby Lavergne radioed the Stewards and reported that jockey Wilfredo Lozano Jr. on the #7, “Kooldealjonsteill,” wanted to claim foul against Keiber Coa the rider of the #6, “Nekia’s Edge,” for interference. The objection was posted on the infield tote board. When the riders returned to the unsaddling area, we spoke to Mr. Lozano who informed that he did not claim foul, but wanted the Stewards to review the race specifically where the #1a, “Paytoplay” ridden by Martin Solis came over in front of him at the five-eighths pole. It was noted that the #1a and #7 finished sixth and seventh respectively. The Stewards will hold film review with the riders regarding this race.
