Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

**FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m.** #5, “Northbound and Out,” was a vet scratch. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 4 - 6 - 2.” Starters - 5**

**SECOND RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:47 p.m.** Roimes Chirinos, named on #1, “Precious Daughter,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. Jorge Vargas Jr., scheduled to ride #2, “Punkin’s Pride,” was changed to Angel Serpa; no double jocks mount. Javier Felix Jr., named on #4, “Village Reward,” was changed to Mario Rodriguez; no double jocks mount. Trevor McCarthy, scheduled to ride #6, “Les Miards,” was changed to Horatio Karamanos; no double jocks mount. #8, “Stylish Step,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. The #5, “Grin,” was scratched by the Stewards on the advice of Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, as the horse was not warming up well. **INQUIRY AT THE TOP OF THE STRETCH - Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Mario Rodriguez rider of the #4, “Village Reward,” against the #6, “Les Miards,” ridden by Horacio Karamanos. The claim of foul was in reference to the #6, “Les Miards,” coming in causing jockey Rodriguez to steady his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. We noted that the #6 did come in during the stretch run, but did not come over in front of the #4. The Stewards felt that the rider of the #4 over reacted while steadying horse and bumping the rail.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 2 - 7 - 3.” Starters - 7**

**THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m.** Jose Ferrer, named on #3, “Royal Almighty,” was changed to Brian Pedroza; no double jocks mount. #4, “Orbital Flight,” and #5, “Dr Blarney,” were vet scratches. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 4**

**FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:49 p.m.**  
Abel Castellano Jr., scheduled to ride #7, “Hauler,” was changed to Carol Ceden0; no double jocks mount. Erik Barbaran, named on #8, “Chantage,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. #5, “Nickos Red Star,” was a vet scratch. #9, “Angelic Faith,” and #10, “Sloneker’s Star,” were scratched as alternates. #6, “Stormy Alex,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #8, “Chantage,” broke slowly.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 3 - 6 - 11.” Starters - 8**

**FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m.** #2, “Motin,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. **Hold and claim of foul** by jockey Mario Rodriguez aboard the #5, “Isolation Road,” against the #6, “Motor City,” ridden by Scott Spieth. The claim of foul was in reference to the #6, “Motor City,” allegedly bumping jockey Rodriguez horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official as the #6 and #4 were close but never made contact with each other. No inquiry was called by the Stewards into the running of this race. #7, “Balto More,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “6 - 5 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 6**

**SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:48 p.m.**  
Andrew Wolfson, named on #2, “Colmont Kid,” was changed to Brian Pedroza; no double jocks mount. Lauralea Glaser, scheduled to ride #4, “Just a Scip,” was changed to Janelle Campbell; no double jocks mount.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 2 - 5 - 6.” Starters - 8**

**SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:18 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:21 p.m.** #1, “Avanzando,” was a vet scratch. The #5, “El Pichon,” was scratched by the Stewards on the advice of Commission Veterinarian Jane Teichner, as the horse was not warming up well.

**ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 7 - 4 - 6.” Starters - 5**

**EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:49 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:50 p.m.** Kerwin Clark, scheduled to ride #4, “Ray Knows,” was changed to Ricardo Chiappe; no double jocks mount. Vicente Gudiel, named on #7, “Aurora’s Kid,” was changed to Keiber Coa; no double jocks mount. #1, “Ima Wildcat,” was a vet scratch. #7, “Aurora’s Kid,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
