Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

“OWNERS DAY AT THE RACES”

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Sample #14591 collected on August 25, 2015 which was previously on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis was cleared.
- Sample #15331 collected on August 26, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was returned positive for “Clenbuterol.” This sample was collected from “Trouble Kid,” the winner of the first race on August 26, 2015. Ramon Preciado the trainer of record, requested a split sample which will be sent to Industrial Labs in Wheat Ridge, Co.
- Samples collected on August 29, and 31, 2015 were cleared, with the exception of sample #14496 collected on August 29, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.
- Samples collected on September 1, and 2, 2015 were cleared with one exception; that being # 14838 collected on September 2, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. #1, “Tori’s Guy,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #2, “Dilatory,” and #5, “Star of Sarava,” were vet scratches. #6, “Aragvi,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #5, “Wycombe Abbey,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #8, “Bwana Barbie,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. #1, “Subtle Intent,” was claimed by Juan Coronel – Owner Trainer.

THIRD RACE – THE NEW CASTLE STAKES - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:16 p.m. #1, “Impressive Roberto,” was scratched by Commission Veterinarian, Richard Brown, after an incident in the paddock where it flipped and fell to the ground. Dr. Brown initially suspected a pre-existing medical condition may have contributed to the fall. Dr. Brown assessed the matter and euthanized “Impressive Roberto.” The horse was then removed from the paddock via horse ambulance. #6, “Unzapped,” was scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. We canceled Trifecta, Superfecta and Show wagering for this race as we were below five betting interests. *Note: “Impressive Roberto” was sent to New Bolton Center for necropsy.*

FIFTH RACE – THE SMALL WONDER STAKES - POST TIME – 3:17 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:18 p.m. Roimes Chirinos, named on #3, “Andiemac,” was changed to Eric Camacho; no double jocks mount. Victor Rodriguez, scheduled to ride #9, “Sun Stricker,” was changed to Martin Solis; no double jocks mount. #1, “Holiday Wishes,” was scratched as part of a same-owner entry. #5, “Gotta Redhot Shot,” and #11, “Alberta Clipper,” were scratched by the racing office to re-enter. #7, “Celestial Insight,” and #10, “Broken Bridle,” were scratched in compliance with the stakes race provision rule 11.14.1.1. #4, “La Murette,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

SEVENTH RACE – THE FIRST STATE DASH STAKES - POST TIME – 4:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:17 p.m. #1, “Patrick Rocks,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 7 - 8 - 5.” Starters - 8

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:44 p.m. OFF TIME – 4:46 p.m. #9, “Cowtown Brown,” was claimed by James C. Wolf – Kieron Magee. #1, “Truth Only,” broke slowly.

ORDER OF FINISH – “10 - 9 - 1 - 8.” Starters - 10
