Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

The Delaware Thoroughbred Racing Commission met this morning at 10:15 a.m.

Administrative Proceedings:

We held a hearing on Tuesday, September 15, 2015 for veterinarian Dr. Donald Johnson. The hearing was conducted for failure to list the treatment for the injury of the two-year old unraced horse "Bismarck Tullio" on Wednesday, August 5, 2015 on his daily treatment slips. During the hearing, mitigating circumstances were brought up which in the Stewards opinion were significant enough to hold Dr. Johnson blameless in this matter. Mitigating circumstances included that Dr. Johnson treated the horse on an emergency basis since no other veterinarian on the grounds was available at the time and that the horse was not racing. According to the testimony, Dr. Johnson did not bill for the service and hence had forgotten to list the treatment on his daily treatment slip.

Post-race test results from Truesdail Laboratories, Inc. revealed the following:

- Sample #14496 collected on August 29, 2015 which was placed on hold awaiting a certificate of analysis, was cleared.
- Workout sample #15150 collected on September 3, 2015 for the horse "Media's Delite" trained by Anthony Pecoraro was returned positive for betamethasone. The horse "Media's Delite" must re-work and pass the testing procedure at the owner's expense, before being eligible to race again.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. HOLD AND CLAIM OF FOUL by jockey Jomar Ortega, rider of the #3, "Filled With Wonder," against the #6, "Fantasmagorico," ridden by Carol Ceden. The claim of foul was in reference to the #6, "Fantasmagorico," coming over in front of #3, "Filled With Wonder," during the run at the quarter pole and forcing jockey Ortega to check his horse. After talking to the riders involved and reviewing the films of the race, the Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official as the #3 came out during the stretch run behind the #6 who had kept a straight course. No inquiry was called by the Stewards, into the running of this race. #7, "Justforgetaboutit," was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. A mistake on the program was detected by the Clerk of Scales, James Houghton that jockey on the #1, “Knee Socks,” should have read “Alex Canchari,” and not “Alex Cintron.” #1, “Knee Socks,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. *Note: The correction was noted on Equibase, the TV displays and announced over the public address system.*

THIRD RACE – POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:18 p.m.

FOURTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:50 p.m. #2, “Passion Trail,” was scratched as a main-track only. #5, “Janine’s Approval (IRE)” was claimed by Warwick Stable – A. Ferris Allen III.

ORDER OF FINISH – “9 - 5 - 4 - 1.” Starters - 9

FIFTH RACE – POST TIME – 3:16 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:17 p.m. #5, “Proud Patriot,” was scratched by the racing office to re-enter.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 7 - 8.” Starters - 7

SIXTH RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 3:46 p.m. OFF TIME – 3:49 p.m.
INQUIRY STRETCH RUN – HOLD AND CLAIM OF FOUL by #8, “Devil’s Blush,” with rider Alex Canchari against the #6, “Free d’Or,” with rider Kerwin Clark, for coming in and forcing his horse in causing crowding on the inside. This caused the #3, “Lotta Irish,” with rider Ricardo Chiappe and the #10, ‘I’m Smokin Hot,’ with rider Christian Navarro to fall in the stretch. The #6, “Free d’Or,” was disqualified from second and placed last for coming in down the stretch causing the #8, to take up along with causing the #3 and #10 to fall. Jockeys Chiappe and Navarro were transported to hospital for evaluation. #7, “Rock, Roll Diva,” was scratched as the horse was not eligible for race conditions. #2, “Right Or Wrong,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “2 - 8 - 1 - 9.” Starters - 9

SEVENTH RACE – POST TIME – 4:42p.m. OFF TIME – 4:43 p.m. We experienced a fifteen minute delay due to the spill in the sixth race, waiting for the transport ambulance to return from hospital. Ricardo Chiappe scheduled to ride #1, “Pamzine,” was changed to Daniel Centeno; no double jocks mount. #5, “Bonnet Plume,” was sent for a Stewards special test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “7 - 4 - 6 - 1.” Starters - 7

EIGHTH RACE – POST TIME – 5:13 p.m. OFF TIME – 5:13 p.m. #3, “Tea Time,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “3 - 5 - 4 - 2.” Starters - 6

Ricardo Chiappe scheduled to ride #4, “Uptown Dannys Boy,” was changed to Carol Ceden; no double jocks mount. #6, “Jewell AA,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.
