Administrative Hearings:

On Tuesday, May 26, 2015 we tested an Assistant Trainer/Exercise Rider who tested positive for marijuana. The subject waived his right to a formal hearing and was suspended pending evaluation and recommendation from the horsemen's Drug and Alcohol counselor. The counselor Ms. Nan Bernardo M.S.C.C. must send the Stewards a written evaluation and recommendation, before a reinstatement hearing will be considered.

S.,” was selected for a blood gas test. We had a 15 minute delay in the start of this race, as we had two late scratches at the gate. The #8, “Big Lee,” was scratched by Associate Commission Veterinarian Richard Brown, as the horse had flipped in the gate being injured. The #12, “Corinthian Summer,” was scratched by Dr. Brown, as the horse had pulled a shoe loose, cutting its leg with the loose shoe.

We received an all clear from outrider Colby Laverne for this race. We called Mr. Parrot and he told us that he thought that she said that she had dropped her whip at the three eights pole. After the call from Ms. Cedenó the Stewards reviewed the alleged incident again, seeing no reason to take any action.
