Approved scratches for today, reviewed and filed veterinarian daily treatment sheets and blood gas test results.

FIRST RACE – POST TIME – 1:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:16 p.m. Tyler Conner, named on #1, “Sacred Ground,” was changed to Robert Paz; no double jocks mount. Ricardo Chiappe, scheduled to ride #4, “Time for Spring,” was changed to Scott Spieth; no double jocks mount. Christian Navarro, named on #5, “Senor Castrico,” was changed to Ever Argueta; no double jocks mount. #4, “Time for Spring,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test.

ORDER OF FINISH – “4 - 2 - 3 - 1.” Starters - 6

SECOND RACE – POST TIME – 1:45 p.m. OFF TIME – 1:46 p.m. #2, “Charlottes Dream,” was scratched by its trainer. **INQUIRY IN MID STRETCH** - The #3, “I’m Really Sumthin,” with rider Daniel Centeno drifted out in mid stretch. The #5, “Passion Trail,” with rider Mario Rodriguez over reacted, shying outwardly when the #3 drifted out brushing the #5. No hold or claim of foul was lodged in this race. The Stewards saw no reason to take any action and made the race official. We canceled Superfecta wagering for this race as we were below six betting interests.

THIRD RACE – ON THE TURF - POST TIME – 2:15 p.m. OFF TIME – 2:17 p.m. Jose Lopez scheduled to ride #3, “Congressionalstorm,” was changed to Miguel Osorio; no double jocks mount. Ricardo Chiappe scheduled to ride #10, “Vianney Lane,” was changed to Scott Spieth; no double jocks mount. #11, “Fiery Star,” #12, “Trish’s Wish,” and #13, “Lulu Island,” were scratched as alternates. **INQUIRY SHORTLY AFTER THE START** – The #6, “Charlotte’s Girl,” ridden by Carol Ceden started bucking shortly after the start. Jockey Ceden pulled up, dismounted, and handed the reins to the outrider. #5, “Passion Police,” was selected for a pre-race blood gas test. The Starter, Mr. Robert Sydor placed “Charlotte’s Girl” on the “Starters List” for additional schooling.
